Monday Nov 23rd
Commenced equally with fresh breeze
from the S. E. steering on the
wind to the Westward under double
reefed topsail & courses jib & sprit
sheet down the fore staygalant
mast & riged in the flying jib
thus ends saw nothing
Lat 34 1/2 N
Long 1 20 W

Tuesday Oct 24th
Commenced equally with fresh breeze
from the S. E. steering on the
wind to the North under close
reefed topsail foresail & mainspanner
at 6 A.M. set double reefed topsail
jib & mainsail in the afternoon it
cleared off & made S.W. sail
thus ends

Long 14 30 W

Wednesday Oct 25th
Commenced cloudy with light
breezes from the S. E. steering
the wind to the North with full
sail thus ends saw nothing
Lat 34 1/2 N
Long 14 1/2 W

Wednesday Nov 8th
Commenced cloudy with fresh breeze
from the S. steering on the wind
to the S. at night took in sail
saw nothing at 1/2 P.M. finished
boiling broke out the main hatch
& stowed down the oil thus ends
Lat 35 29 N
Long 10

Thursday Nov 9th
Commenced cloudy with fresh
breezes from the S. steering to
under close reefed main topsail
& foresail at 10 P.M. commenced
raining at 6 came on foggy
at 11 A.M. cleared up set double
reefed topsails thus steered on the
wind thus ends wind S. E.
Lat 35 50 N
Long 10 20 W

Friday Nov 10th
Commenced cloudy with fresh
breezes from the S. E. steering
on the wind with all sail set
at night took in sail at 10 P.M.
the wind hauled to the S.W.
steered S. E. under close reefed
main topsail & fore sail at day
light made sail saw several
finbacks thus end pleasant
Lat 35 56 N
Long 9 43 W
