Friday Nov 24<sup>th</sup>

Commences cloudy with fresh breeze  
from the N laying too under  
close reefed maintop sail main sheet  
er & foretopmast staysail & the  
wind hauled to the W thus  
ends

Saturday Nov 25<sup>th</sup>

Commences cloudy with strong  
from the N laying too, under  
reefed main top sail main sheet  
& foretopmast staysail at 3 P.M. set  
the foresail & foretop sail saw one  
Dutch ship at night took in sail  
at daylight made all sail steering W  
fresh breeze & rain at 10 took in  
topgallant & double reefed the top  
thus ends

Sunday Nov 26<sup>th</sup>

Commences squally with strong breeze  
from the N steering W under  
double reefed topsail & foresail at 11  
took in sail & luffed too at 3 P.M.  
the wind hauled to the N at 12  
hauled to the W at 4 hauled  
too the S laying too thus ends  
strong breeze

Lat 36, 03  
Long 60 35 W

Monday Nov 27<sup>th</sup>

Commences clear with fresh breeze  
from the N laying too at 1 P.M.  
set double reefed topsails foresail &  
mainsail & at night took in  
sail at daylight made all sail steering  
S, E at 8 P.M. the wind died away  
at 12 past 8 the wind came to the N  
thus ends with light breezes

Lat 36, 16 S  
Long 60, 51

Tuesday Nov 28<sup>th</sup>

Commences fallant with fresh  
breeze from the N steering E  
with all sail set at night took  
in sail at daylight set double  
reefed topsails & courses & jib  
steering E saw several finbacks  
thus ends with fresh breeze

Lat 35, 44 S  
Long 60, 11, 6
