

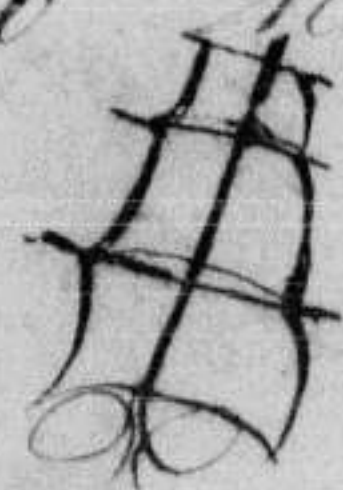
Barge Pembroke

At 11 steering E, S, E under double reefed topsail & fore sail at 3 P.M. steered S at 5 P.M. luffed S W saw several finbacks at night took in sail & luffed for the E. at daylight set close reefed foretopsail & foresail steered S, W, W with strong breeze at 10 took in the foretopsail & foresail & luffed too to the E thus ends

Commences cloudy with strong breeze from the S, W laying too under close reefed main topsail mainsprit & fore topmast staysail at night came on fog at 1 P.M. set double reefed topsail & foresail steering S, W at 8 set the mainsail & jib steering S thus ends saw two humpbacks

Commences cloudy with fresh breeze from the S steering E, S, E under double reefed topsail & foresail at 6 P.M. took in sail & luffed too came on fog at daylight made sail wind W spoke the Thomas Dickerson S, H steering E, S, E thus ends Lat 36 18 N

Commences pleasant with light breezes from the W steering E, S, E with full sail set in company with the Thomas Dickerson at night took in sail middle part clear at daylight made steering E, S, E in company with the Thomas Dickerson saw several finbacks thus ends

Sunday Dec 3rd

Commences pleasant with light breezes from the S, W steering E, S, E under all sail set saw two right whales going quick to the S, W lowered butt could not get nigh them at night took in sail & luffed too middle part equally at daylight kept her of E, S, E under double reefed main topsail & foresail at 6 set the fore topsail at 10 took it in thus ends
