 double reefed topsails at 6 P.M.
 close reefed the maintopsail &
 took in the foresail & foretopsail
 middle part squally at daylight moderate
 made all sail steering S.E. by E.
 thus ends saw nothing

Tuesday Dec 12th
 Commences squally with strong breeze
 from the N.W. steering S.E. with
 whole topsails & foresail at 5 P.M.
 took in the foresail & foretopsail &
 close reefed the main & luffed too
 at 4 set double reefed topsails & fore-
 sail at 8 made all sail steering S.E.
 strong breeze from the N.W. thus ends

 took in the foresail at 2 set the
 foresail at 4 part 2 took in the fore
 topsail at 3 set it again steered
 S.E. through the night under close reefed
 topsails & foresail at 6 AM shook the
 reefs out of the topsail & set the
 maintopgalantsail at 9 the wind hauled to
 the W. set the jib & mainsail ends cloudy
 Lat 38, 04
 Long 20, 33

Friday Dec 15th
 Commences squally with fresh breeze
 from the W. steering S.E. with all
 sail set took in the mainsail & jib
 at 4 P.M. took in the maintopgalantsail
 at 7 double reefed the topsails
 at 1 P.M. took in the foretopsail
 & close reefed the main steering
 S.E. by S half S under close reefed main
 topsail & foresail at 6 set the fore
 topsail and turned one reef out of
 the main steering S.E. by E thus ends
