Commences pleasant with fresh breeze from the N.W. steering S.W. with all sail set saw one ship at 6 am on fog took in sail mid part fog & squally at daylight made sail steering on the wind to W saw several pinbacks thus ends

Thursday Jan 4th
Commences pleasant with fresh breeze from the N.W. steering on the wind to the W with all sail set saw several pinbacks at night took in sail at middle part squally & foggy at daylight made sail steering on the wind to the W cloudy & foggy thus ends

Friday Jan 5th
Commences cloudy with fresh breeze from the W steering S.E. by E with all sail set at 6 P.M. spoke the Gen. say Harbor Capt. Worth 4 whales also the Flora N. Be. Capt. Cuning saw several sulphur bottoms at night took in sail mid part squally at 8 made sail steering on the wind to the W wind S.W. saw Iceberg thus ends

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Saturday Jan 6th
Commences pleasant with light breeze from the W.S.W. steering on the wind to the S with all sail set at night took in sail mid part pleasant at daylight made sail steering on the wind later part calm thus ends saw nothing

Sunday Jan 7th
Commences pleasant with light breeze from the N.W. steering on the wind to the S.W. with all sail set at night took in sail mid part calm at daylight made sail steering W by N wind N.E. thus ends saw nothing

Monday Jan 8th
Commences pleasant with light breeze from the N.E. steering W with all sail set at 5 P.M. spoke the Meteor of Groton at night took in sail & luffed too mid part pleasant at daylight made sail steering thus ends gaining with the Meteor saw nothing
