

Barque Pembroke 1844

Monday Jan 15th

Commenced squally with strong gales from the ~~SW~~ laying too under clost reefed maintopsail foretopmast staysail & mainstaysail middle part squally at 6 A.M. set the foresail at 9 took it in this end

Lat 43, 42 S
Long 50, 42 W

Tuesday Jan 16th

Commenced squally with strong gales from the W laying too under clost reefed maintopsail mainstaysail & foretopmast staysail middle part more moderate set the foresail at 8 A.M. set the foretopmast staysail steering S on the wind in company with the Neptune at 11 saw two right whales lowered but could not strike them it too rough to haul to the windward thus ends

Wednesday Jan 17th

Commenced squally with strong gales from the NW steering on the wind to the S at 1 P.M. took in sail middle part squally at 11 A.M. set the foretopmast staysail & spanker steering on the wind saw several right whales lowered but could not strike them thus ends squally

Long 50, 50 W

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Thursday Jan 18th

Commenced squally with fresh breeze from the N steering on the wind in company with the Neptune at night took in sail middle part squally came on to blow a heavy gale laying too under clost reefed maintopsail mainstaysail & foretopmast staysail at 4 the wind hauled to the W wore ship thus ends

Lat 44, 24 S
Long 50, 35 W

Friday Jan 19th

Commenced squally with strong gales from the W laying too under clost reefed maintopsail mainstaysail & foretopmast staysail towards night it moderated saw the Neptune to the leeward middle part more moderate at daylight set double reefed topsails spoke the Julius Caesar & Capt Green 1200 likewise the Neptune thus ends

Lat 44, 21 S
Long 50, 52 W

Saturday Jan 20th

Commenced squally with strong breeze from the N steering on the wind under double reefed topsails in company with the Julius Caesar & Neptune at night took in sail middle part squally at daylight set the foretopmast staysail steering on the wind saw two right whales saw several ships thus ends
