Tuesday Feb 6th

Commences cloudy with strong breeze from the W steering on the wind. At 2 P.M. double reefed the topsails & at 3 P.M. took in sail middle part squally with strong gales at daylight set the foresail & wore round at 10 took in sail double reefed topsails at 11 made all sail saw nothing ends calm got no obs^r

Wednesday Feb 7th

Commences cloudy with calm having all sail set at night took in sail middle part squally with strong breeze from the N.E. at daylight set the foresail came in thick fog thus ends saw 2 ships got no obs^r

Thursday Feb 8th

Commences with thick fog laying too under close reefed maintopsail & foresail with strong breeze from the N.E. at night took in the foresail at daylight set the foresail thick fog at 8 A.M. it cleared up made sail steady on the wind spoke the Julius Caesar 1400 lbs. saw one right whale going 40 knots thus ends

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Friday Feb 9th

Commences cloudy with light breeze from the N steering on the wind. At 10 the N.E. with all sail set in company with Julius Caesar at 11 took in sail middle part squally & foggy with fresh breeze at daylight set single reefed topsails & jib at 10 came in thick fog took in sail thus ends

Saturday Feb 10th

Commences squally & foggy with strong breeze from the N. laying too under close reefed maintopsail & foresail at 4 P.M. the wind hauled to the W wore round the fog cleared off saw 4 ships middle part pleasant at daylight made sail steering on the wind at 11 saw 1 right whale lowered but could not strike him saw 4 ships thus ends

Sunday Feb 11th

Commences pleasant with light breeze from the W steering on the wind with all sail set in company with the Genedoes at night took in sail middle part squally with strong breeze from the E at 6 A.M. set the foretopsail at 7 took it in took in the foresail blowing a heavy gale thus ends saw several ships got no obs^r

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
