Friday March 8th

Commences cloudy with fresh gales from the N.E. steering W under double reefed topsails & courses at 3 P.M. took in sail & luffed too middle part squally at 8 till set the foresail do later part more moderate thus ends saw nothing

Clinton Smith Lat 43, 37 S Long 50, 29 E

Saturday March 9th

Commences pleasant with strong breeze from the W laying too under close reefed main topsail & foresail at 2 P.M. set the foresail steering on the wind at night took in sail at daylight set double reefed topsails at 11 made all sail steering S.E. saw two right whales lowered but could not strike them thus ends cloudy with strong breeze

Sunday March 10th

Commences cloudy with strong breeze from the N steering on the wind with all sail set at night took in sail middle part foggy at 10 till made sail steering on the wind saw nothing thus ends

Lat 44, 04 S Long 50, 55

Monday March 11th

Commences pleasant with light breezes from the N.E. steering on the wind with all sail set at 2 P.M. came on fog at 4 the fog cleared up saw 13 right whales lowered but could not strike them at night took in sail middle part squally & rainy later part foggy thus ends

Lat 43, 42 S

Tuesday March 12th

Commences foggy with strong breeze from the N steering laying too middle part pleasant at day light made sail steering S.E. by E with all sail saw several sulphur bottoms thus ends

Lat 44, 06 Long 50, 43



Wednesday March 13th

Commences pleasant with light breezes from the W steering on the wind with all sail set saw one right whale lowered but could not strike him at 1 P.M. saw one lowered & chased him 4 hours & finally struck him killed him & brought him along side & got one boat stove took in sail at daylight commenced cyting started the tryworks & made sail steering on the wind thus ends
