Thursday March 14<sup>th</sup>

Commenced pleasant with light breezes from the N steering on the wind at night took in sail sailing middle part pleasant later part strong breeze thus ends saying too saw nothing Got no observation

Friday March 15<sup>th</sup>

Commenced pleasant with light breezes from the W steering on the wind with all sail set saw one ship at night took in sail middle part squally with strong breezes at daylight set the foresail & stowed down the oil thus ends fog Got no observa

Saturday March 16<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with thick fog with fresh breezes from the N & W laying too under close reefed maintopsail middle & later part the same saw nothing Got no observation no latitude

Sunday March 17<sup>th</sup>

Commenced foggy with strong breeze from the N laying too under close reefed maintopsail & reefed foresail middle part the same at 11 it cleared off thus ends saw nothing Lat 44, 08 Long 51, 51

Monday March 18<sup>th</sup>

Commenced squally with fresh gales from the N & W laying too under close reefed maintopsail & foresail middle & later part the same saw nothing Lat 44, 19 S Long 50

Tuesday March 19<sup>th</sup>

Commenced squally with strong gales from the W laying too under close reefed main topsails & mainpenceer at 9 P.M. took in the maintopsail middle & later part the same saw nothing Lat 43, 40

Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup>

Commenced squally with strong gales from the W laying too under mainpenceer & fore topmast staysail at 11 set the close reefed maintopsail at daylight set double reefed topsails & courses steering N & E thus ends saw nothing Lat 42, 32 Long 52, 52

Thursday March 21<sup>th</sup>

Commenced pleasant with strong breeze from the W steering N & E under double reefed topsails & courses at night took in sail middle part pleasant at daylight made sail steering N & E thus ends saw nothing Lat 41, 29 Long 53, 10 E
