

Barge Pembroke

Wednesday, Apr 17th
Commences squally with fresh breeze
from the N.W. laying too under close
reefed maintopsail & foresail middle part
squally later part pleasant with strong breeze
so ends Lat 36, 27
Long 23, 53

Thursday Apr 18th
Commences pleasant with strong breeze
from the W. laying too under main
topsail & foresail at 12 the wind hauled
to N.W. made sail steering on the wind
and calm saw one ship Lat 36, 47
Long 23, 15

Friday Apr 19th
Commences pleasant with calm breeze
all sail set at 4 P.M. spring up a breeze
from the S.E. steering N.W. middle part
squally double reefed the topsails, at 8 took
in the mainsail & jib, at 10 took
in the foretopsail close reefed the main,
& reefed the foresail so ends with fresh
gale, wind hauled to N.W. Lat 37, 02
Long 20, 38

Saturday Apr 20th
Commences squally with fresh gales from
the N.W. laying too under close reefed main
topsail & reefed foresail middle part blowing
a heavy gale took in the foresail later part
the same blowing heavy Lat 37, 01
Long 19, 50

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Sunday Apr 21st
Commences squally with strong gales from
the W. laying too under close reefed main
topsails middle part more moderate at
6 set the foresail at 8 set the fore
sail close reefed at 9 let one reef out of the
maintopsail & set the jib steering on the wind
heading N.E. W. so ends Lat 36, 44
Long 18, 48

Monday Apr 22nd
Commences pleasant with fresh breeze
from the N.W. steering on the wind
with double reefed topsails & jib middle
the wind from the S.E. light made all
sail later part the same steering so ends
saw nothing Lat 35, 50
Long 17, 26

Tuesday Apr 23rd
Commences pleasant with light breeze from the
S.E. steering N.W. with all sail set at
8 took the wind hauled to S.E. W. at 11.4.16 saw
a shoal of killers ends pleasant Lat 35, 28
Long 14, 43

Wednesday Apr 24th
Commences pleasant with light breeze from
S.E. W. steering N.E. W. with all sail set
at 12 the wind hauled S sent up the fore
topgallant mast so ends Lat 34, 26
Long 12, 52

Thursday Apr 25th
Commences pleasant with light breeze from the S
steering N.E. W. with all sail set middle
part squally took in the topgallant sails & double
reefed the topsail later part squally with thunder
& lightning & rain so ends Lat 32, 58
Long 11, 18
