Friday June 14th
Commences pleasant with light breeze
from the E steering W by N with all
sail set at night took in sail
at daylight made sail steering W by N
saw ends saw two ships Lat 20° 48' S
Long 27° 00' W

Saturday June 15th
Commences squally with fresh breeze
from the E steering W by N with all
sail set at night took in sail
at daylight made sail steering W by N
at 11 double reefed the topsails the
wind hauled to N. E. & saw two ships
saw ends Lat 20° 53' S
Long 28° 48' W

Saturday June 16th
Commences pleasant with light breeze
from the E steering W with all sail
set at 2 P.M. saw Cape Grio on the coast
of Brasil bearing S by E steered W by N
saw several sails later part the same
saw ends Lat 23° 18' 45" S
Long 42° 08' 45" W

Sunday June 17th
Commences pleasant with light breeze
from the E steering W by E with
land in sight at 2 P.M. spoke the
Brazilian Corvette & second of July & made
her at 4 part 3 saw the Isle of Pajaralaya
at 4 saw the Isle of Grade bearing W by S
run for it at 6 double reefed & stood
up and on at 8 P.M. made all sail
stood in for the land sent a boat
in to find the Harbour saw ends

Monday July 1st
Commences pleasant with fresh breeze
from the E & the boat came off saw
no Harbor run off & sent a boat in
again saw the Harbour of Eschela took
Pilot which took us in to Palmas came
to anchor at 4 part 5 in 6 fathoms of water
in the morning broke out the water cask
& sent a boat crew ashore to cut wood
saw ends

Tuesday July 2nd
Commences pleasant with light breeze
from the E a boat crew ashore cutting
wood sent the cork ashore at night came
off in the morning the boat crew went
ashore again to cut wood saw ends
Palmas

Tuesday July 3rd
Commences pleasant with the boats
crew ashore cutting wood got off some
water & hauled the spik & black bar
bends at night the boat came off
from the woods in the morning went
ashore again saw ends

Wednesday July 4th
Commences pleasant boats crew ashore
cutting wood at night came off
in the morning all hands went ashore on
Liberty saw ends

Thursday July 5th
Commences pleasant at night the crew
came off in the morning the boats crew
went into the woods saw ends
