Saturday July 6th
Commences pleasant with light breeze
boats crew ashore out & backing again
at came off in the morning went
ashore again so ends

Sunday July 7th
Commences pleasant with light breeze
boats crew ashore at night came
off middle part squally so ends

Monday July 8th
Commences rainy with light breezes
from the S.W. all hands ashore on
liberty except 6 at night came off
except 1 Manuel fire runaway in the morning
boats crew went ashore backing and
so ends

Tuesday July 9th
Commences pleasant boats crew
ashore and backing were and getting it
off to the ship at night came off
in the morning got off the rest
the wood so ends

Wednesday July 10th
Commences squally with fresh breeze
from the N.W. employed in stowing
away the cargo at 10 the Capt &
boats crew started for Villa Grande
got off 3 casks of water so ends

Thursday July 11th
Commences squally with strong breeze
from the S.W. employed in stowing
in the morning sent down the fresh water
so ends

Friday July 12th
Commences pleasant with strong breeze
from the S.W. at 3 came on squally the
Capt got back so ends

Saturday August 2nd
Commences cloudy with fresh breeze
from the N.W. got under weigh and
came out of Palmas Harbor in company
with the Cadmus Delta Romulus &
Marcus bound to Tristan De Acunha
ends calm

Monday August 26th
Commences squally with strong breeze
from the N.W. laying too at daylight
made sail & kept off E. by S. 1/2 N.W.
at 11 A.M. saw the Island of
Inaccessable so ends

Tuesday August 27th
Commences cloudy with fresh breeze
from the N.W. steering for the
land at 1 P.M. saw the Isles of Tristan
De Acunha & fightingale at 2 P.M.
lost sight the topsails and huffs too
off shore at night took in the foremast
at daylight made sail & steered for
the land at 8 the boats went in
shore at 11 came off saw no whales
steered for the large Island so ends
