Wednesday Aug 28<sup>th</sup>

Commenced squally with fresh breezes from the N.E. steering for Tristan. At 2 P.M. the boats went in shore saw one whale at night came off took in sail middle part squally at daylight made sail & steered in for the land at 10 boats & went in shore spoke the Cadmus Bay Harbor & the Romulus so ends

Thursday Aug 29<sup>th</sup>

Commenced squally with fresh breezes from the N.E. steering up to the land at 2 P.M. the boats came off saw no whale steering on the water to the E. in company with the Romulus & Cadmus at night took in sail at daylight made sail beating up to the land end so ends



Friday August 30<sup>th</sup>

Commenced squally with strong breezes from the N.E. steering on the wind spoke the Bingham of Boston Capt. Claridge came sat up till 10 took in sail at daylight set double reefed topsails & courses standing in for the land so ends

Saturday Aug 31<sup>st</sup>

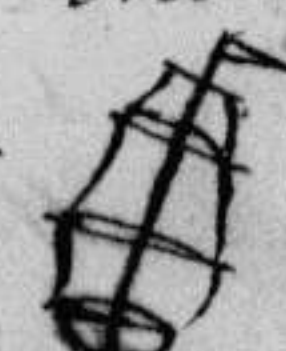
Commenced cloudy with fresh breezes from the E. & E. laying at anchor with the Bingham at night took in sail at daylight made sail standing in for the land at 10 steered N.W. for night began so ends with fresh breezes N.E. & E.

## Barque Pembroke

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Sunday Sept 1<sup>st</sup>

Commenced squally with fresh breezes from the N. steering for Nightingale at 1 lowered & went in shore saw 2 whales but could not strike them spoke the boats of the barque gentleman of New Suffolk saw the Cadmus & Romulus at night took in sail at 11 took in the foresail so ends blowing a gale



Monday Sept 2<sup>nd</sup>

Commenced cloudy with fresh gales from the N. laying too under close reefed maintopsail mainshipper & foretopmast staysail saw one sail off the weather quarter at 10 the wind hauled to the S.W. wore ship at daylight made sail steering for the land so ends



Tuesday Sept 3<sup>rd</sup>

Commenced pleasant with light breezes from the S.E. steering for the land with all sail set at night took in sail & luffed off shore at daylight set double reefed topsails & ran off for Inaccessible at 8 lowered & went in shore saw one whale but could not strike him so ends



Wednesday Sept 4

Commenced squally with fresh breezes from the S.E. standing off & on the Isle of Inaccessible at 2 the boats came off & brought 3 lbs of Elephant blubber at night took in sail at daylight furled the foresail so ends laying too strong breezes
