Our Company with the Delta at 4 p.m. spoke her & at night took in sail in part squally at 8 took the wind from to the W. more ship heading N.E. in company with the Delta and with fresh breeze

Friday Sept 13

Commenced pleasant with strong breeze from the N.W. staying too under main top & foresail at night wore round heading S. land astern at daylight set double reefed topsails & courses starting for on the wind at 10 the wind hauled to the N.W. were ship land bearing N.W. & N. sounds

Saturday Sept 14

Commenced pleasant with fresh breeze from the N.W. steering on the wind at 2 p.m. took in the mainsail & fore at 4 took in the foresail & close reefed the main. middle part squally at daylight set double reefed topsails & courses

Sunday Sept 15

Commenced pleasant with light breeze from the N.W. steering on the wind under single reefed topsails & courses at 3 p.m. spoke the same Michel & L. chon the Candace Reed & L. 1200 also the Delta Capt. went on board middle part squally at 12 took in sail at daylight set double reefed topsails at 10 the Capt. came on board so ends

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Monday Sept 16



Commenced pleasant with light breeze from the N.W. steering on the wind with all sail set on reefing with two bandages & fairs at 1 about on board of her at night took in sail at day light set double reefed topsails & courses steering for the land at 3 the boats went in shore spoke the Jason & L. chon sounds



Tuesday Sept 17

Commenced pleasant with light breeze from the N.W. steering on the wind saw the Stilton & Scipio from at 1 the boats came off at 2 went on board of the Jason at night steering for Incepsville at 6 the boats went in shore saw nothing started at Nightingale got some Eggs & fresh seals



Wednesday Sept 18

Commenced pleasant with fresh breeze from the N.W. steering off on the land at 4 the boats came off at 5 off shore at night took in sail at daylight set close reefed topsails & courses steering for the land so ends



Thursday Sept 19

Commenced cloudy with fresh breeze from the N.W. steering on the wind took in sail at 5 saw more ship at daylight made sail steering for the land at 8 at 10 the boats went in shore saw no whales got 11 fur seals ends calm saw several ships
