

# Barque Pembroke

**Friday Sept 20<sup>th</sup>**  
Commences pleasant with light breeze from N.W. standing off & on the land at 3 the boats came off saw the Delta Candace, Midas, Henderson & Jason at took in the jib & mainsail & lost reefed the topsail middle & later part cloudy saw two seals

**Saturday Sept 21<sup>st</sup>**  
Commences cloudy with light breeze from the S.W. steering on the wind under lost reefed topsails & foresail land being N.W. by W. at night took sail at daylight set double reefed topsails at 9 made all sail came on squally double reefed the topsails took in the jib & mainsail wind N. savends Clinton

**Sunday Sept 22<sup>nd</sup>**  
Commences squally with strong breeze from the N. steering on the wind under double reefed the topsails & foresail at 8 took in the fore topsail & lost reefed the main at 6 took in the fore sail & set the main spencer middle & later part the saw ends with fresh gales.

**Monday Sept 23<sup>rd</sup>**  
Commences squally with strong gales from the N. laying too middle part more moderate at 8 set double reefed topsails & steered for the land at 10 saw it so ends saw a shoal of black fish Lat. 37.52 Long 11.16

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**Tuesday Sept 24<sup>th</sup>**  
Commences squally with strong breeze from the S. steering for the land at 2 luffed two heading W.S.W. at night took in sail middle part strong gales at 11 took in the main topsail so ends strong gales from E.S.E. got no obs j

**Wednesday Sept 25<sup>th</sup>**  
Commences with strong gales from the E.S.E. laying too under main spencer & fore topmast staysail at 4 the gale abated set the maintopsail cost reefed middle part more moderate saw one ship ends with strong gales from the N. got no obs

**Thursday Sept 26<sup>th</sup>**  
Commences with strong gales from the N. laying too under lost reefed maintopsail main spencer & fore topmast staysail middle & later part the same saw two ships so ends Lat 38 39 S

**Friday Sept 27<sup>th</sup>**  
Commences with strong gales from the North laying too under cost reefed main topsail main spencer & foretopmast staysail saw one ship middle & later part the same so ends Lat by obs 38.56 S Long by Obs 11.18 W

**Saturday Sept 28<sup>th</sup>**  
Commences with strong gales from the N. laying too at 6 PM the wind hauled to W. middle part squally at daylight set lost reefed topsails & foresail steering N.W. wind W.S.W. ends squally with fresh gales Lat 38 26 Long
