

Barque Pembroke

Sunday Sept 29th

Commenced squally with fresh gales from the W S W steering N N W under close reefed topsail & foresail at night took in sail & luffed for middle part more moderate at daylight set close reefed topsail & foresail steering for the land spoke the Barque Caroline N York Capt Rose so ends

Monday Sept 30th

Commenced pleasant with fresh breezes from the N S W steering on for the land under double reefed main topsail & close reefed fore topsail & foresail spoke & went on board of the Romulous S H at night took in sail 6 ships in sight middle part calm at daylight made sail steering for the land at 6 the boats went ashore saw several whales but did not get any saw several ships so ends

Tuesday Oct 1st

Commenced squally with fresh breezes from the E S E steering on the wind under double reefed topsails & foresail spoke the Candace N S the Jason Do also the Bengal N S Capt Frink 1 whale saw the Liverpool 2nd New Bedford the Caroline the Romulous saw another Barque to windward at night took in sail started off from the land middle part same at 5 made sail steering for the land saw several ships so ends

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Wednesday Oct 2nd

Commenced squally with boisterous winds from the S W & S E steering for the land saw several ships at 3 wore ship & started off shore at night took in sail at daylight set double reefed topsails & foresail steering for the land at 8 the boats went in shore wind W so ends with 6 or 7 ships in sight

Thursday Oct 3rd

Commenced pleasant with fresh breezes from the W standing off & on the land boats in shore at 14 came off saw a shoal off blackfish lowered & got 2 at night took in sail middle part the same at daylight made sail steering N E saw nothing so ends Lat 36 24 Long

Friday Oct 4th

Commenced pleasant with fresh breezes from the W steering N E with tides & equinox at night took in sail middle part squally at daylight set double reefed topsails steering on the wind at 8 wore round set the mainsail & jib saw nothing so ends Lat 35 29 W Long 10 33 W

Saturday Oct 5th

Commenced squally with fresh breezes from the S W steering on the wind to the W S W with double reefed topsails & courses at night took in sail middle part squally with strong gales later part the same Lat 36 12 Long
