Commences cloudy with rain & fresh breeze from the E.N.E. steering W with all sail set at 2 PM took in the main topgalantsail & double reefed the topsail at night took in sail & luffed too middle part fresh breeze later part the same laying too saw nothing so ends Lat 36.24 Long 11.44

Tuesday Oct 8th

Commences cloudy with fresh breezes from the N. laying too under close reefed ~~main~~ maintopsail & foresail & main spence & foretopmast stayball middle part more moderate at daylight made sail steering on the wind to the N.W. so ends Lat 36.37 Long 11.48 W

Wednesday Oct 9th

Commences hazy with fresh breeze from the N.W. steering on the wind at 3 PM saw the land bearing N.S.W. at night took in sail middle part pleasant at daylight made sail steering on the wind wind S saw nothing so ends Lat 36.34 Long 12.11
