Commences pleasant with strong breezes from
the W.N.W. laying too under close reefed
main topsail middle part cloudy wind hauled
to the N at daylight set double reefed top
sail steering on the wind spoke the ship
Thomas Dickerson S.B. clean sails

Thursday Oct 24th

Commences squally with strong breezes from
the N steering on the wind under double
reef topsails at 1 PM spoke the Atlantic
King Myrtle clean at 2 took in sail middle
part squally later part the same ends
laying too Wind W saw nothing
