Friday Oct 25<sup>th</sup>  
Commences pleasant with fresh breeze from the W laying too under close reefed main topsail & foresail middle part more moderate at day it made all sail staying on the wind at 8 spoke the shift Julian N.B. Bathaway clean so ends saw several finbacks  
Lat 35, 34 S  
Long 8 - 54 W

Saturday Oct 26<sup>th</sup>  
Commences pleasant with light breeze from the W steering N.E. with all sail set at night took in sail middle part the wind hauled to S at daylight made all sail steering W.N.W. saw nothing so ends

Sunday Oct 27<sup>th</sup>  
Commences pleasant with light breeze from the S.E. steering W.N.W. with all sail set at night took in sail middle part calm at daylight made sail steering W. saw nothing so ends  
Lat 35, 09 S  
Long 9 35 W

Monday Oct 28<sup>th</sup>  
Commences pleasant with light breeze from the E steering W with all sail set at night took in sail at daylight made sail steering on the wind so ends  
Lat 35, 33 S  
Long 10, 06

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Tuesday Oct 29<sup>th</sup>  
Commences pleasant with light breeze from the W steering on the wind the S. at night took in sail at daylight made sail steering W at 8 spoke the Hibernia Smith N.B. clean & the Colombia Kelly so ends  
Lat 36, 01  
Long

Wednesday Oct 30<sup>th</sup>  
Commences pleasant with light breeze from the N.E. steering on the wind in company with the Colombia & Hibernia at night wore round middle part pleasant later part the same saw nothing so ends  
Lat 36, 48 S  
Long 10, 57 W

Thursday Oct 31<sup>st</sup>  
Commences pleasant with light breeze from the N.E. steering W with all sail set at daylight night took in sail at daylight made sail steering W. saw the Islands saw two ships so ends  
Lat 36 44 S

Friday Nov 1<sup>st</sup>  
Commences cloudy with fresh breeze from the N.E. steering W by S with all sail set at night took in sail & luffed too off shore at daylight made sail steering for the land so ends  
Lat 37, 58 S  
Long 11, 25 W
