Commences pleasant with light breeze
from the N.N.E steering for the land
at night took in sail
buffed too off shore middle squally
& rolling laying too so ends Lat 36 38
Long 10 00

Sunday Nov 3rd
Commences foggy with fresh breezes from
the S.E. laying too under short
sail maintopsail & foresail middle part
pleasant at daylight made sail steer
on the wind saw several ships at
E & M since the ship Elizabeth N.B.
E & a clean so ends Lat 36 38
Long 10 00

Monday Nov 4th
Commences pleasant with light breezes from
N.W steering on the wind with all sail
set in company with the Elizabeth
at night took in sail at daylight
made sail steering on the wind so ends
Lat 36 10
Long 10 55

Tuesday Nov 5th
Commences pleasant with light breezes
from the N.W steering on the wind
with all sail set at night took in
sail at daylight made sail steering
on the wind saw two whales so ends
Lat 35 41
Long 10 11

at night took in sail at daylight
made sail wind S. saw nothing
