

Remarks on board of Bark Perry 1878  
Monday Jan 21<sup>st</sup>

Came with strong trade squally & an ugly sea on ship heading S.E. & S.E. by E. Mid part the same Lat part do at 6 6 a.m. tried the pumps don't seem to work very well found some water 45 strokes watch employed variously in ship duty so ends

Lat 15-11 N

Tuesday Jan 22<sup>d</sup> Long

Came with strong trade ship on port tack heading S.E. by S. at 11 P.M. heading S by E. tacked ship heading N.E. with all sail and except fore top gal sail mid part occasional rain squalls Lat part strong breeze heading N.E. by N one sail in sight steering northward so ends

Lat 16-48 N

Long 69-27 1/2 W

Wednesday Jan 23<sup>d</sup>

First part cloudy & strong trade ship heading N.E. by N. watch employed breaking out for water provisions & various articles also felling casks with salt water at 4 P.M. tried pumps 30 strokes mid part good breeze tacked ship at 11 P.M. heading S.E. by E. Lat part strong breeze watch variously employed so ends

Lat 16-20 N

Thursday Jan 24<sup>th</sup> Long 69-00 W

Came with strong trade & occasional rain squalls ship on port tack heading S.E. at 5 P.M. pumped ship 150 strokes from starboard pump the port pump don't throw any water & get holds water. I have tried to draw the lower hold with watch tackles but can't seem to start it am fearful of trifling much with it as I might make bad matter worse the ship leaks in her upper works while carrying sail but none in her bottom saw a sail steering N.W. mid part good breeze

Geo. W. Mickelson Master 1878  
at 4 past 11 tacked ship heading N.E. saw two large Barks steering westward Lat part squally with rain saw several vessels steering westward so ends this day

Friday Jan 25<sup>th</sup> Lat 17-55 N

Came with squally rain Long 68-24 W weather & wind from eastward saw a steamer steering eastward also 3 other sails steering W.N.W. caught a cowfish tacked ship at 4 P.M. at 5 P.M. pumped ship 150 strokes mid part good breeze Lat part do

East point of Mono Island bearing N.E. 1/2 E. Dist 25 miles this day ends very moderate

Saturday Jan 26<sup>th</sup> Long

This day begins with light air from the eastward ship heading N.W. at sundown the east end of Mono Island bearing S by E 1/2 E. Dist 25 miles at 5 P.M. pumped ship 85 strokes mid part fine breeze Lat part do at 4 past 8 a.m. saw white water off the weather bow at 9 o'clock tacked for it at 11 saw nothing more of it tacked again to northward so ends

Sunday Jan 27<sup>th</sup>

Came with fine weather & light breeze E.N.E. ship by the wind on starboard tack watch variously employed saw one pinkack & caught a dolphin mid & lat part do so ends

Monday Jan 28<sup>th</sup> Long

Came with fine weather & good breeze from the eastward ship N.W. at 4 P.M. pumped ship 53 strokes mid part do Lat part do wind hauling to southward ship heading E & by S Light breeze & sea smooth so ends
