

Remarks on board Bark Perry 1878

Sunday Feb 17th

Came with fine weather & Light trades N.E. heading northward by the wind breaking out for provisions & water at 4 P.M. pumped ship 30 strokes mid & Lat part do at 10 Am saw a Merchant ship steering steering N.Ward. at 4 A.M. wore ship heading S by E. saw plenty of Wharve so ends
Lat 12-57 N
Long 42-02 W

Monday Feb 18th

Came with fine weather & Light trades ship heading S by E. at 4 P.M. pumped ship 45 strokes find she leaks a little in her bottom mid do Lat part good breeze at 4 A.M. wore ship heading to northward the day ends with a good breeze from the Eastward. Lat 13-11 N
Long 42-20 W

Tuesday Feb 19th

Came with with a good trade ship heading N.W.E. pumped ship at 4 P.M. 37 strokes. mid & Lat part Light breeze E. heading N by E. saw a sail steering northerly so ends Lat 13-11 N
Long 42-18 W

Wednesday Feb 20th

Came with a fresh trade E. & pleasant weather at 1 A.M. saw a sail steering to N.W. watch employed breaking out for water & prov. at 4 P.M. pumped ship 20 strokes mid part do Lat part strong breeze E.N.E. heading N. so ends
Lat 13-10 N
Long 41-31 W

Thursday Feb 21st

Came with fresh breeze E.N.E. & thick smoky weather ship heading N. pumped ship at 4 P.M. no water. at sundown ship heading N. mid & Lat part ^{breeze} E.N.E. & thick weather (Lat 13-30 N

Friday Feb 22nd

Came with a fine breeze E.N.E. steering off S by W tried the pumps at 4 P.M. no water at 1/2 past 5 P.M. luffed to the wind heading S by E. at Sundown shortened sail mid & Lat part fresh breeze E by N. & cloudy. at 3 A.M. wore ship heading S.S.E. so ends. Lat 12-54 N
Long 42-44 W

Sat Feb 23rd

Came with a mod. breeze E.N.E. & smoky weather steering off N. by W. at 4 P.M. pumped ship no water at sundown shortened sail & came to the wind. mid part under. Lat part at 1/2 past 6 Am made sail & saw a Brig to wind Ward at 8 Am we gammed proved to be the Clifford of Barbados Capt Bugby. so ends this day with smoky weather & Light wind heading S.E. by E. Lat 13-09 N
Long 43-15 W

Sunday Feb 24th

Came with light wind & smoky heading S.E. still gamming at 4 P.M. tried the pump no water. at sundown finished gamming & shortened sail for the night mid. part fine breeze at mid night tacked ship Lat part strong breeze at daylight tacked again & made sail heading S.E. wind E.N.E. the Brig not in sight this day with strong breeze & smoky which is bad for the eyes. saw one pinback (Lat 12-36 N
Long 42-59 W

Monday Feb 25th

Came with cloudy smoky weather & strong breeze E.N.E. ship heading S.E. at 4 P.M. pumped ship 75 strokes mid part strong breeze & a heavy sea on. breaking out for water & prov Lat part do so ends

Lat 11-43 N
Long 42-25 W
