

Remarks on board of Bark Perry 1878

Saturday March 16th

Came with a gale from the E. ship under
Close reefed topsails m staysail & P staysail
heading N. at 4 P.M. pumped ship 300
strokes Leak seems to be in the upper works
Mid part do Lat part begins to moder-
ate a little At 9 A.M. saw a Brig
do ends

Long 39-46 W

Sunday March 17th

Came with strong breeze E by N ship heading
N by E. at 4 P.M. pumped ship 600 strokes
cannot ascertain where the leak is but think
it is about the upper works same where mid
& Lat part fresh breeze & cloudy weather
heading S.E. At 11 A.M. spoke Schi Lunick
steamer of Provincetown

Monday March 18th

Came with strong breeze E.N.E. & cloudy weather
at 1 P.M. saw blackfish lowered L. & W. boats
& chased. came on board at 5 P.M. without
success. pumped ship 740 strokes Leak
seems to increase. mid part do. heading S.E.
Lat part strong breeze at 6 A.M. tacked ship
heading N. do ends

Lat 13-07 1/2

Long 38-57 W

Tuesday March 19th

Came with strong trades cloudy & a heavy
sea on ship heading N. at 2 P.M. saw
Breaches off the weather beam 3 miles made
sail & went for them at 4 P.M. pumped
ship 800 strokes at 5 P.M. whales 6 miles
off going quick to windward mid part
squally Lat part same & a rough sea in
watch employed heaving and for provisions
do ends

Cruising on twelve Futz Ground 1878

Wednesday March 20th

Came with fresh trades E.N.E. ship heading
S.E. saw a merchantman steering northward
at 4 P.M. pumped ship about 800 strokes
at 5 saw white water a long way off the
weather beam mid part do Lat part from
7 A.M. until 9 equally with rain saw a
pinback this day ends with fine weather
& smoother water

Lat 13-05 N

Long 39-39 W

Thursday Mar. 21st

Came with fine weather & light breeze & a
considerable swell on saw a schooner to leeward
ship on starboard tack heading N.N.E. at 2 P.
M. kept off for her at 4 pumped ship 480 strokes
at 5 P.M. spoke the Wm Grozier Capt Roberts
Capt went on board at 1/2 6 boat returned
& braced forward on port tack heading S.S.E.
mid part strong breeze Lat part more mod
the Grozier in sight to leeward also a merchant
Bark northward bound. do ends

Lat 13-15 N

Long 39-43 W

Friday March 22^d

Came with cloudy smoky weather & a good breeze &
steering S.S.E. by the wind the Wm Grozier still
in sight to leeward also another whaler a Brig
& a merchantman northward bound. at 3
P.M. saw blackfish did not lower they were
going quick to windward at 4 P.M. pump-
ed ship 700 strokes. mid part good breeze
Lat part same the Wm Grozier & the Brig
still in sight. saw porpoises

do ends this day
