Thursday May 14<sup>th</sup>

Corn with strong breeze E.S.E. ship heading N.E. at 4 P.M. pumped ship 250 strokes at 7 P.M. saw a Brig steering westward mid part do Lat part wind changed to S.S.W. steering N.E.

Wednesday May 15<sup>th</sup>

Corn with a strong breeze S.W. steering N.E. pumped ship at 4 P.M. 300 strokes a heavy sea on mid part same Lat part steering N.E. by E. saw 2 sail steering N.W. also saw one pinback so ends

Thursday May 16<sup>th</sup>

Corn with a strong breeze S.W. cloudy & a rough sea on steering N.E. pumped ship at 4 P.M. 450 strokes mid part wind W. steering N.W. Lat part fine breeze N.W. steering N. watch employed fitting & painting waist Boat. so ends

Friday May 17<sup>th</sup>

Corn with fine weather & good breeze N.W. steering N. saw a sail steering S.E. watch variously employed at 4 P.M. pumped ship 385 strokes mid part do Lat part same employed mending sails & fitting waist Boat so ends

Saturday May 18<sup>th</sup> Long

Corn with strong breeze N.W. steering N.N.E. employed repairing sails at 4 P.M. pumped ship 400 strokes wind increasing took in the light sails mid part do Lat part same & an ugly sea on so ends

Sunday May 19<sup>th</sup>

Corn with a strong breeze N.N.W. ship heading N.E. under single reefed topsails & a heavy sea on pumped ship at 4 P.M. 600 strokes mid part same Lat wind increasing & blowing a young gale steering N. so ends

Monday May 20<sup>th</sup> Long 53-01 W

Corn with a strong breeze W.N.W. steering N.E. at 4 P.M. pumped ship 800 strokes at 5 P.M. steering E.N.E. saw a sail steering E.N.E. mid equally Lat part strong breeze & a rough sea on ship under short sail steering E.N.E. so ends

Lat 32-07 N

Tuesday May 21<sup>st</sup> Long 53-21 W

Corn with a strong W.N.W. & occasional rain squalls steering E.S.E. saw a big steering westward at 4 P.M. pumped ship 900 strokes mid part more moderate latter part strong breeze weather improving so ends

Wednesday May 22<sup>d</sup>

Corn with with a good breeze west steering E.S.E. at 4 P.M. pumped ship 650 strokes & Braced the yards by the wind & steering by wind heading S.S.W. mid part moderate Lat part fine weather & smooth sea at 8 m kept off S.E. so ends

Thursday May 23<sup>d</sup>

Corn with fine weather & good breeze W.N.W. steering N.E. at 2 P.M. saw a white water 2 points of the sea bow ran for it which proved to be a school of pinbacks lubbed on our course again pumped ship at 4 P.M. 430 strokes at sunset shortened sail for the night & came to the heading N by E.
