

Remarks on board of bark Perry 1878

Saturday June 1st

Came with strong breeze N.W. & cloudy.
Ship heading N.E.W. a heavy sea on
pumped ship at 4 o'clock 700 strokes
mid part heavy sea & strong breeze
Lat part same watch employed rep-
airing foretopmost staysail as ends

Long 43-53 W

Sunday June 2^d

Came with a strong breeze N.W. & a heavy
sea on steering W.S.W. at 4 P.M. pump-
ed ship 805 strokes also bent the fore-
topmost staysail mid part do & Lat
part the same at 8 am ship heading W
Wind N.W. 20 ends Lat 36-48 N

Long 46-02 W

Monday June 3^d

Came with a breeze N ship heading N.W. W
at 4 P.M. pumped ship 900 strokes & spoke
the Brig Abbot Lawrence & jammed at 8
P.M. finished jamming mid part steering
W by south Lat part light wind N.W. W
& a heavy swell N. do ends Lat 36-32 N

Tuesday June 4th

Came with light air W.W. W. steering E at
4 P.M. pumped ship 600 strokes mid
part steering W by S. Lat part strong
breeze bent a new main topsail & chan-
ged the main forward & sent down the
old one for repairs so ends

Wednesday June 5th

Came with fresh breeze W by N steering E by S
at 4 P.M. pumped ship 200 strokes mid part
Moderate Lat part Lat part do with some
rain steering E by S so ends

Thursday June 6th Long 40-52 W

Came with fine weather & light breeze W.N.W.
steering E by S. pumps attended to Lat part
Mod. & cloudy Lat part light air & calms

Lat 37-58 N

Long 39-49 W

Friday June 7th

Came with light baffling wind & cloudy employed
repairing the foretopmast pumps attended to
at sunset shortened sail for the night mid
part Moderate Lat part do at daylight
made sail steering E by N employed repairing
topmast saw plenty finbacks so ends

Lat 38-27 N

Saturday June 8th Long 39-42 W

Came with light breeze west & cloudy steering S by W
saw a number of sulphur bottomes & finbacks at
4 P.M. pumped ship 30 strokes at sundown
shortened sail & came to the wind heading W
by N. mid part equally Lat part do at day-
light made sail & kept off N by E. wind S.W.
by W. finbacks plenty so ends Lat 37-53 N

Long 39-49 W

Sunday June 9th

First part Cloudy & equally & drizzling rain
wind west pumps attended to No water mid
part Made steering N by E. Lat Calms & light
air one sail in sight so ends

Lat 39-41 N
