Friday June 28th

Came with a strong breeze N. Cloudy
 & a heavy sea on tried the pumps at
 4 P.M. 300 strokes mid & Leat part
 Breeze strong heading E.N.E. so ends
 Lat 46-15 N
 Long 23-30 W

Saturday June 29th

Com. with a strong breeze N. & a heavy sea
 on ship heading E.N.E. pumped ship at 4
 P.M. 850 strokes saw several sails also
 saw porpoises mid part blowing a young
 gale & heavy squalls Lat part same
 so ends Lat 48-33 N
 Long 20-29 W

Sunday June 30th

Com with squally weather & strong breeze
 N.W.W. & a heavy sea on ship heading N.E.
 at 2 P.M. were ship heading N.W.W. mid
 N.W.E. at 4 P.M. pumped ship 1000 strokes
 at 5 P.M. came to anchor mid part good
 weather Lat part do & quite a smooth
 sea at 9 A.M. wind N.E. heading N.W.W.
 with Mod. breeze so ends Lat 48-43 N
 Long 21-50 W

Monday July 1st

Com with fine weather & smooth sea &
 a good Breeze N. heading N.W. by W. saw
 Saampace finbacks & porpoises pumped ship
 at 4 P.M. 300 strokes mid part wind N.W.
 ship heading N.S.W. Lat part moderate
 at 6 A.M. were ship heading N.N.E. caught
 1st a porpoise so ends
 No Obs

Tuesday July 2^d

Com with calm foggy weather two sails in
 sight Merchant Man saw finbacks at
 4 P.M. tried the pumps 20 strokes Lat part
 4 P.M. came to breeze S.E. steering N. mid
 part do Lat part wind S. & cloudy so ends
 Lat 49-43 N
 Long 23-00 W

Wednesday July 3^d

Com. with strong breeze N steering N at 2 P.
 M. Com. to be foggy & some rain pumps
 attended to several vessels in sight at 5 P.M.
 jamming the Bark Ohio Capt Smith at
 7 P.M. finished 1500 blb of sperm
 2 years out. shortened sail & stood on part
 tack heading N.S.W. mid part same Lat
 part strong breeze S.S.W. & foggy so ends
 No Obs.

Thursday ~~Wednesday~~ July 4th

Com. blowing a gale S.W. & thick misty
 weather & a heavy sea running saw sulphur
 bottoms & porpoises at 4 P.M. pumped ship
 1300 strokes mid part still blowing strong
 Lat part begins to moderate with rising
 Barometer ship heading W. one sail in
 sight so ends Lat 49-40
 Long 23-37

Friday July 5th

Com with a good breeze S.W. & fine weather &
 a heavy swell running two sails in sight
 saw plenty finbacks & porpoises at 1 P.M.
 ship heading S.S.E. pumped ship at 4 P.M.
 800 strokes at sunset shortened sail for the
 night mid part strong breeze Lat part do
 at day light made sail again wind S.W.
 & very rugged weather Bark Ohio in sight
 so ends Lat 49-48 N
 Long 23-31 W.
