

## Remarks on Board Bark Perry 1878

Saturday July 6<sup>th</sup>

First part strong breeze S.W. & rugged weather  
at 4 P.M. pumped ship heading 209  
strokes at 5 P.M. spoke Bark Ohio Capt  
Winslow but did not gain it being too  
rugged Mid & Lat part strong breeze with  
thick rainy weather saw porpoises finbacks  
& Merchantman so ends

Lat 49-50 N

Sunday July 7<sup>th</sup>

Long 23-18 W

Began with squally rainy weather & strong  
breeze tried the pumps at 4 P.M. 1200 strokes  
Mid part wind W.S.W. heading N.W.  
Lat part fine weather & light breeze so ends

Lat 49-44

Monday July 8<sup>th</sup>

Long 23-13 W

Came with good weather & light breeze S.W.  
pumped ship at 4 P.M. 500 strokes at 5  
P.M. gained the Bark Daniel  
whether one year out with 450 lbs of sp.  
um oil finished gain at sunset & short-  
ened sail & stood on port tack heading  
W.S.W. mid part fine lat part foggy  
with light breeze saw porpoises so ends

Tuesday July 9<sup>th</sup>

Long 23-46 W

Came with thick foggy weather & light breeze  
W. ship heading S.S.W. pumped ship at 4 P.  
M. 300 strokes one sail in sight to S.W. mid  
& lat part wind W.S.W. heading  
S.W. so ends this day

Wednesday July 10<sup>th</sup>

Long

Came with light breeze N.W. & a thick fog  
ship heading W.S.W. at 4 P.M. pumped  
ship 90 strokes & caught a porpoise mid  
& Lat part wind variable big thick fog  
two sails in sight so ends

Long 24-09 W

## Geo W. Nickerson master 1878

Thursday July 11<sup>th</sup>

Came with a light breeze W. & foggy saw a  
sunfish ship heading W.S.W. pumped ship at  
4 P.M. 30 strokes Mid part do Lat part  
same at 2 P.M. wore ship wind S.W.  
heading W.S.W. at 6 A.M. came to breeze  
saw a number of birds sitting on the water  
so ends

Lat 48-03 N

Friday July 12<sup>th</sup>

Long 24-06 W

Came with thick rainy weather at 3 P.M.  
Clear with a fresh breeze W.S.W. ship heading  
N.W. at 4 P.M. pumped ship to water also  
saw a white water & mile off sea beam ran  
for it but did not see it a gain mid  
part strong breeze ship under short sail lat  
part Mod. & Cloudy weather & a heavy  
sea on one sail in sight so ends

Lat 47-00 N

Saturday July 13

Long 26-20 W

First part Cloudy Wind N.W. ship heading  
W.S.W. a heavy swell on pumped ship at  
4 P.M. 30 strokes Mid part Mod. lat  
part Calm one sail in sight so ends

Lat 46-17 N

Sunday July 14<sup>th</sup>

Long 27-20 W

First part foggy by spells & calm saw 10  
sails at 2 P.M. light breeze N. steering  
W.N.W. at 4 P.M. tried the pumps to water  
saw grampases & finbacks Mid part do  
Lat part foggy saw a swordfish  
lowered for it but did not catch it  
so ends

Lat 45-48 N

Long 28-09 W
