Saturday Aug 3rd

Corn with good weather & a good breeze
N.W.E. ship heading E. & a heavy sea on
pumps attended to mid part calm
Lat part good breeze S.S. or steering E & S
so ends Lat 38-06 N
Long 33-15 W

Sunday Aug 4th

Corn with fine weather & good breeze S.S.
W. steering E & N. pumps attended to
picked up a barrel of Kerosene mid part
wind S.S.E. & cloudy Lat part thick &
squally wind canting to Eward ship
heading N.W. by E so ends at 11 a.m.
saw three hares E by S. dist 20 m. Lat 38-50 N
Long 32-04 W

Monday Aug 5th

Corn with moderate breeze & variable
pumped ship 40 strokes mid part squally
Lat part do the East point of Flores
bearing N.E. by E dist 20 m. Capt no letter
heard for Fayal Lat 38-31 N
Long 30-31 W

Tuesday Aug 6th

Corn with cloudy weather & wind var-
ying from N.E. to E.N.E. ship on port
tack pumps attended to mid part
foggy by spells & wind N.W.E. steering
E by S. At 1 a.m. spoke a whale by ship
said Fayal was bearing S.E. by E & E.
Lat part mod. saw Fayal at 9 a.m.
bearing E. dist 35 miles so ends
Lat 38-13 N
Long 29-53 W

Wednesday Aug 7th

Corn with fine breeze N.W.E. ship heading
E. tried the pumps 30 strokes at 4 p.m. ship
in the Malabon. Fayal town 20 miles dist
Capt went on shore at sunset ship lying
off & on the town mid part calm lat
part breeze S.W. at 7 a.m. hoard came on
board with orders for me to cruise around the
Islands a week Capt under doctors care
& so ends steering Eastward
Lat 38-52 N
Long 28-30 W

Thursday Aug 8th

Corn with a good breeze S.W. the N. end
of St George bearing S. dist 4 miles gramp-
ses in sight in all directions at sunset
shortened sail between graccovia tereeria
mid calm lat part squally with var-
iable winds cruising off graccovia plenty
of grampses in sight so ends No Obs.

Friday Aug 9th

Corn with squally weather weather & varia-
ble winds at sunset tereeria bearing
S.S.E. dist 15 miles pumps attended
to mid part squally lat part fine
plenty of grampses in sight so ends.

Saturday Aug 10th

Corn with fine weather & good breeze
E.N.E. cruising off tereeria & whaling
ship in sight at sunset N point of
tereeria bearing S by W. dist 15 miles mid
part mod. Lat part fine breeze from
S.S.E. saw a Brig steering Nward so ends
No Obs.
