

Remarks on board Bark Perry 1878

Sunday Aug 11th

Came with Calms & light air a scho in sight saw plenty jacksnipes. pumps attended to at sunset N. point of terceria bearing S by W. dist 25 miles Mid part No Lat part N. point of terceria bearing S.S.W. dist 10 miles A scho in sight also saw grassy meads & so ends this with light air E.N.E. & Cloudy

Monday Aug 12th

Came with light breeze N.W. at 4 P.M. jammed the scho. Aleyone of purimacora Capt Fisher & month and 20. lbs pumps attended to at sunset N. point of terceria bearing S by W. dist 15 mile Mid part fine Lat part squally with some rain at day light terceria rock bearing S.S.E. dist 6 miles & so ends this 24 hours with squally weather scho Aleyone in sight

Tuesday Aug 13th

Came with with cloudy weather wind N.W. scho Aleyone in sight. pumps attended to. at sunset N. point of terceria bearing S.W. by S dist 8 miles Mid part moon. Lat part strong breeze W by N. scho not in sight so ends

Wednesday Aug 14th

Came with a strong N.W. breeze between terceria & graciosa St George W. point bearing S.W. dist 20 miles Mid part calm Lat part squally with some rain at daylight S. point bearing N.W. dist 10 miles so ends

Geo. W. McKesson Master 1878

Thursday Aug 15th

Came with calms & clear weather St George S. point bearing N. dist 20 miles pumps attended to at 4 P.M. saw a school of killers & lowered for them without success Mid part wind N.W. & squally with some rain Lat part fine weather at daylight the N. end of Pico bearing N.W. dist 35 miles Wind N.W. ship heading S.W. fine weather & light breeze so ends

Friday Aug 16th

Came with light variable winds at 6 P.M. took a heavy squall of wind & rain from E.S. steering N.W. at sunset N. point of Fayal bearing N. dist 40 miles Mid part heavy rain squalls ship under short sail Lat part wind N.E. by N. & blowing heavy by squalls so ends

Saturday Aug 17th

Came with strong breeze & squally weather Wind N.W. steering E. Fayal bearing N.E. dist 30 miles Mid part squally pumps attended to 200 strokes Lat part fine weather & calms at 8 A.M. came to brace from S.W. Fayal bearing N.E. dist 25 miles from the town sent the 3^d note on shore for the Capt. at 11 A.M. ship lying off & on the town two scho in sight off the W. side of Pico so ends

Sunday Aug 18th

Came with cloudy weather & light wind S.W. ship lying off & on the Town of Fayal at 4 P.M. came to be squally pumps attended to at 6 P.M. Capt came on board looking & feeling a little better but by far not a well man at 7 P.M. shortened sail to close reefed topsails blowing very heavy S.W. in squalls steering N.W. wind
