

Remarks on board Bark Perry 1898

Mid part squally with rain at 10 P.M.
Came to the wind heading, W.N.W. Last part
Wind N. & blowing a young gail pumper
attended to & cloudy weather at 4 A.M.
Kept off steering between St George & Pico
so ends

Monday Aug 19th

Corn. with strong breeze & squally weather
steering between St George & Pico. pumper
attended to. At sunset Terceira N point
bearing N by E. dist. 25 miles Mid part
mod. hot part Calm a sch. in sight to
the S.W. so ends

Tuesday Aug 20th

Corn with Light breeze S.W. a Berquentine
in sight steering N.E. a heavy swell on
from the N. at 4 P.M. pumped ship
400. strokes Mid. part mod. Lat part
a good breeze N.W. S. end of St George
bearing S.W. dist 10 Am she 6 miles
saw porpoises so ends.

Wednesday Aug 21st

Corn with a strong breeze N. & cloudy weather
& a heavy swell on from the N.W. at
4 P.M. pumped ship 600. strokes at sunset
the N point of Terceira bearing S dist 12
miles Mid. part rainy Lat part cloudy
the Island of Terceira bearing the N. point
S.S.E. at 12 M. St. George S point bearing W
N.W. dist 5 miles Wind W.N.W. fine weather &
smooth sea so ends

Thursday Aug 22^d

Corn with fine weather & good breeze N.W. Capt
improving fast pumper attended to. Mid No
Lat part Light breezes so ends

Friday Aug 23^d

Corn. with a light breeze W.N.W. Crossing of the
W. side of Pico pumper attended to. Mid part
fine Lat part the same the S.W. end of Pico
at 12 M bearing N. dist fifteen miles. so ends.

Saturday Aug 24th

Corn with a light breeze W. steering eastward
through & between Fayal & Pico saw a whaler
Bark steering into Fayal pumper attended to
at sunset S point of Terceira bearing S by W. dist
fifteen miles Mid part thick & rainy by
squalls Lat part the same. saw two merch-
andman one going W. & one we spoke bound in
to Fayal for provisions having run short
her name Maggie Huston of Norwalk at
10 A.M. Fayal S point dist eight miles kept off
for Graciosa so ends

Sunday Aug 25th

Corn. with squally weather wind N.W. at 4
P.M. pumped ship 600. strokes Graciosa
S point bearing N.E. & E. dist 20 miles. Mid part do
Lat part at daylight N. point of Terceira bearing
S by W dist twenty miles so ends with strong
breeze W.N.W. saw plenty Grampuses.

Monday Aug 26th

Corn. with good weather & strong breeze W.N.W.
steering E.S.E. at 3 P.M. saw Brig Gazelle of
Fayal at 4 P.M. tried the pumper 100 onchundred
strokes. & spoke the Sch. Sarah E. Lewis of Boston
Capt Smith & Bannett out Clean at sunset
finished gunnery, & shortened sail for the
night Mid part squally Lat part fine weather
& strong breeze at 10 A.M. Lying off & on
Graciosa trading for potatoes exchanged our 3^d
mate Mr Gilbert with Mr Kelliker 3^d officer of
Sch. Sarah E. Lewis as Mr Gilbert wished to go
home & Kelliker did not the Brig Gazelle also in
sight. so ends.
