Tuesday Jan 21st

Com with fine weather & Light breeze N.E.
pumpes attended to 300 three hundred & seven
shakes Mid & Lat part same so ends

Lat 25-37 S

Wednesday Jan 22nd Long 35-30 W

Beautiful weather & smooth sea pumpes
attended to Mid & Lat part the same
steering S.W. Wind E.N.E. saw a large white
water & ran for it but saw nothing more of it so ends

Lat 26-23 S

Thursday Jan. 23rd Long 36-32 W

Com. fine weather & good breeze E. pumpes attended to
Mid part under short sail Lat part cruising
saw Grampuses so ends

Lat 26-16 S

Friday Jan 24 Long 33-31 W

Cloudy weather Wind E. saw breaches twenty miles
off ran for it but saw nothing pumpes attended
to Mid part under short sail Lat part made
sail so ends

Lat 25-34 S

Saturday Jan 25th Long 36-43 W

Com. with Beautiful weather & smooth sea saw
Grampuses & some drift wood the water changed
from blue to a greenish color Grampuses attended
to Mid part Dist. thunder. Lat part fine
one sail in sight Caught a hully & a surfish
so ends

Lat 26-15 S

Sunday Jan. 26th Long 36-18 W

Com. with fine breeze E.N.E. saw porpoises
pumpes attended to mid part under short sail
Lat part made sail steering N.W. Lat 25-33 S

Monday 27th Long —

Com with strong breeze E.N.E. saw a French
Bark & exchanged signals with her pumpes atten-
ded to. Mid & Lat part steering S.W. so ends

Lat 26-20 S

Long 34-21 W

Tuesday Jan 28th

Com with good weather & fine breeze N.E.
steering S.W. pumpes attended to (250) two
hundred & fifty shakes Mid part under short
Lat part strong breeze steering S.W.
No Obs

Wednesday Jan 29th

Com with good breeze N.E. steering S.W.
pumpes attended to (600) six hundred shakes
Mid part ok Lat part same

Thursday Jan 30th

Strong breeze N.E. steering S.W. pumpes atten-
ded to 900 nine hundred shakes Mid part
raining Lat part fine weather so ends

Lat 30-00 S

Friday Jan 31st Long 42-28 W

Com with good weather & good breeze S
steering W.S.W. pumpes attended to 1
B.M. shortened sail & came to the
wind heading W.N.W. wind S.W. mid
part same Lat part made sail steering
by the wind

Lat 29-48 S

Sat. Feb 1st Long 43-50 W

Com. with fine weather & moderate breeze S.W. ship
heading W.N.W. a heavy sea S.W. pumpes attended
to Mid part E.N.E. steering S. Lat part wind ok
saw Grampuses

Lat 30-18 S

Sunday Feb. 2nd Long 44-19 W

Com with fine weather & smooth sea & light breeze
E.N.E. steering S. pumpes attended to saw Grampuses
Mid part fine Lat part at 11 A.M. boarded
a Spanish Brig Rinc from Mont Video for Rio Jan-
ario Six days out sent letters so ends

Lat 31-51 S

Long 46-09 W
