Monday Feb 3rd

Com. with fine weather & good breeze N.E. ship heading S.S.W. pumps attended to mid part do Lat part at 4 past 5 P.M. saw a large Whale off starboard quarter but came up a Squall & we lost run of him so ends

Tuesday Feb 4th

Long 47-28 W

Com. with fine weather & Light breeze N.E. ship heading S.W. pumps attended to mid & Lat part do so ends

Lat 35-42 S

Wednesday Feb 5th

Long 48-57 W

Com. with fine weather & calms one sail in sight pumps attended saw grampuses & a few birds mid part Light breeze E.N.E. steering S.W. by W. Lat part fine breeze one sail in sight & so ends

Lat 34-54 S

Thursday Feb. 6th

Long 48-42 W

Com. with fine breeze N.W.E. steering S.W. saw Grampuses & one sail pumps attended to mid part Cloudy & some rain Lat part steering W. N. W. Wind increasing. Lat 35-34 S

Friday Feb. 7th

Long 49-38 W

Com. with squally weather & Blowing fresh S.W. heading W. one sail in sight pumped ship at 4 P.M. (600) sixhundred strokes mid part mod. Lat part Calm & light air & a heavy swell S.S.W. Wind west steering N.E. so ends

Saturday Feb. 8th

Lat 35-55 S

Com. with light air west steering Long 49-15 W N.E. saw a large school of Grampuses tried the pumps (450) fourhundred & fifty strokes mid part Moderate Lat part fine breeze ship by the wind heading E. so ends

Lat 33-44 S

Long 48-53 W

Sunday Feb 9th

Com. with fine weather & Light air N. pumps well attended to mid part fine Lat part do so ends

Monday Feb 10th Long 46 Ch

Com. with light breeze E.N.E. & good weather A Brig in sight pumps attended to at sunset shortened sail heading N. Mid & Lat part do two sails in sight

Lat 33-02 S

Tuesday Feb 11th

Long 48-46 W

Com. with fine E.N.E. pumps attended to. at sunset shortened sail for the night mid & Lat part do at daylight made sail again & Ch ends.

Lat 32-26 S

Wednesday 12th

Long 49-32 W

Com. with fine weather & good breeze E.N.E. pumps well attended to mid part Wind changed S.S.E. steering E. Lat part spoke a French Bark from Palas. bound to Calais & so ends Compared Long. which agreed within two or three miles saw grampuses & so ends

Lat 32-10 S

Thursday Feb. 13th

Long 47-48 W

Com. with fine weather & good breeze S.S.E. steering E. saw grampuses pumps attended to mid & Lat moderate so ends

Lat 31-47 S

Friday Feb 14th

Long 47-10 W

Com. with fine weather & Light Breeze S steering E. pumps attended to at 4 P.M. mid & Lat part Calm & so ends

Lat 31-33 S

Saturday Feb 15th

Long 46-32

Calm weather saw Grampuses pumps attended mid part light air S.S.E. steering E. lat palms & so ends.

Lat 31-39 S

Long 46-21 W
