

Remarks on board Bark Perry 1879

Friday May 2^d

Corn. with strong trade both ships by the wind on port tack at 2 P.M. Bertha set pumps for us to come & get our share of the oil at 4 P.M. Oil all on Board (345) three hundred & forty three Gallons to our share. Pumps attended to (500) four hundred strokes Mid part do at 9 P.M. finished garning Lat part at daylight Made all sail & Bertha ship kept steering N.W. by W. ... Lat 12-45 N

Saturday May 3^d Long 45-49 W

Corn. with fine weather & good breeze N.E. steering N.W. by N. the Bertha in sight. pumped ship at 4 P.M. (500) three hundred strokes at sunset shortened sail & came to the wind on starboard tack wind E.N.E. Mid part the same Lat part at daylight kept off steering N.W. the Bertha out of sight Lat 13-38 N

Sunday May 4th Long 47-48 W

Corn. with fine weather & good breeze E.N.E. steering N.W. Pumps attended to at sunset shortened sail & came to the wind on starboard tack heading N. by E. Mid part the same Lat part made sail at 12 M. wore ship. Lat 14-13 N

Monday May 5th Long 47-49 W

Begins with fine weather & light trades ship on port tack by the wind at sunset shortened sail & kept off N. Mid part do Lat part steering N.S.W. Lat 13-38 N

Tuesday May 6th Long 50-20 W

Begins with fine weather & Light trades steering N.S.W. pumps attended to at sunset shortened sail. Mid part do Lat part made all sail steering N.S.W. Lat 13-13 N

Wednesday May 7th

Begins with fine weather & Light trades steering N.S.W. one sail in sight. Pumps attended to. Saw two Humphacks at sunset shortened sail steering W. Mid part the same. Lat part made all sail Employed Washing ship in side & out Lat 13-10 N

Thursday May 8th Long 51-17 W

Begins with fine weather & smooth sea steering W. Mid the same Lat part do employed Cleaning ship & Painting Lat 13-14 N

Long 52-56 W.

Friday May 9th

Begins with fine weather & Light trades wisp. in. Cleaning & Painting ship steering W. Mid part do Lat part three sails in sight steering W. one steering N.W. Mid Cleaning & painting Lat 13-15 N

Saturday May 10th Long 54-44 W

Corn. with fine weather & Light trades steering W. N.S. two sails in sight steering W. saw Humphacks & finished painting ship. Mid part fine Lat part the same two sails in sight steering W. Lat 13-13 N

Sunday May 11th Long 55-05 W

Corn. with fine weather & Light trades steering W. N.S. two sails in sight steering W. pumps attended to. Mid part fine Lat part at 8 A.M. saw the Island of Barbados Bearing N.S.W. luffed to S.W. by W. six sails in sight all merchantman Lat 13-02 N

Monday May 12th Long 59-42 W

Corn. with fine weather at 2 P.M. Capt went on shore at Barbados the Bertha lying here at anchor also several merchantman. At 5 P.M. boat returned to ship. Capt on shore Mid part ship lying off & on Lat part do. at 8 A.M. sent the Boat on shore
