Com. with Calms & Light Air S.E. Pumps
attended to. Mid & Lat part the same.
Lat 30-38 N

Saturday Aug 2nd Long 54-36 W
Com. with light air E. Ship by the wind
on port tack. Pumps attended to. Mid
part do. Lat part saw a ship steering N.W.
at 11 A.M. tacked ship wind S.E. by E.
heading N.E. by E. Lat 29-41 N

Sunday Aug 3rd Long 54-13 W
Com. with light breeze E.S.E. ship on starboard
tack mid & Lat part do. Lat 29-14 N

Monday Aug 4th Long 54-04 W
Com. with light air E.S.E. Bound East
mid & Lat part do. Lat 28-02 N

Tuesday Aug 5th Long 53-38 W
Fine weather & light breeze E.S.E. Ship by the wind
on port tack. Pumps attended to. Mid &
Lat part the same at 10 A.M. tacked
ship heading N.E. by E. Lat 27-27 N

Wednesday Aug 6th Long 53-10 W
Com. with fine weather & good breeze E.S.E. ship
on starboard tack mid & Lat part do
saw Grampuses Lat 28-42 N

Thursday Aug 7th Long 52-19 W
Com. with light air E.S.E. ship heading
N.E. Mid & Lat part fine weather.
Lat 29-27 N
Long 52-08 W

Friday Aug 8th

Com. with calm weather pumps attended
to. Mid part the same Lat part saw
a schr. to eastward also saw Grampuses
& porpoises so ends Lat 29-45 N

Saturday Aug 9th Long 51-40 W
Com. with Calms & Light air N.W. Mid
part same Lat part the same the schr.
in sight Lat 30-06 N

Sunday Aug 10th Long 51-10 W
Com. with Calms & Light air & somewhat
squally. At 3 P.M. went on Board schr.
Hellen. M. Simmons of Provincetown
Capt. Atkiss mid & Lat part light
airs the schr. in sight Lat 30-21 N
Long 50-28 W

Monday Aug 11th
Com. with Calms & Light air the schr. in
sight mid part squally Lat part squally
wind E.S.E. plenty little rips here.
Lat 30-46 N

Tuesday Aug 12th Long 49-35 W
Fine weather Calms & Light air N.W. the
Simmons in sight at 1/2 past 2 P.M. John
Vincent a foremost hand raised 4 whales
also he took down a bounty of 1 Box of
tobacco & box of soap & a pack knife
lowered & hoist at 5 P.M. the 3rd mate
struck at sunset took five whales
along side mid part emp. getting ready
to cut & so ends cutting Lat 30-50 N

Wednesday Aug 13th Long 50-24 W
At 1 P.M. Whales all on board at two
2. started the whips & cutting blubber on
deck mid & Lat part Boiling
Lat 30-30 N Long 50-57 W
