Thursday 14thCom. with fine weather & Light breeze E.
emp. Boiling Miel & Lat part same.

Lat 30-30 N

Friday Aug 15thCom with good weather & light breeze E.
finished boiling at 3 P.M. Miel part
fine Lat part emp clearing up decks

Lat 30-25 N

Saturday Aug 16th Long 50-16 WCom. With fine weather & light breeze
E.S.E. at 3 P.M. Boarded a Portuguese
Bark (22) twentytwo days from Lisboan for
N.Y. & sent letters by her Miel & Lat
part fine

Lat 30-28 N

Sunday Aug 17th Long 49-58 WCom. with fine weather & Light breeze E.
N.E. at 5 P.M. Samed the schr. A.M.
Simmons Boiling Caught a whale yest-
erday which will make then about 12 blks
at 10 P.M. finished gannying Lat
part fine the schr. in sight

Lat 30-57 N

Monday Aug 18th Long 49-45 WCom. with fine weather & light breeze E.S.
E. at 5 P.M. saw whales & lowered 3 boat
whales going quick to N.Y. M. chased until
dark & came on board Miel part lying
aback lat part cruising & stowing down
oil

Lat 31-42 N

Tuesday Aug 19th Long 49-56 WCom. with fine weather & light breeze E.S.E.
emp. stowing down at 4 P.M. finished
Miel part fine Lat part dry

Lat 31-45 N

Long 50-30 W

Wednesday Aug 20thCom. with light breeze E.S.E. & good weather
Miel part same Lat part do. emp.
cleaning ship & coopersing casks.

Lat 30-45 N

Thursday Aug 21st

Long 50-10 W

Com. with fine weather & good breeze
M.S.M. Miel part under short sail Lat
part made sail steering S & E. at 12 M.
saw a white water to windward &
luffed for it.

Lat 31-42

Long 49-55

Friday Aug 22^dCom. with fine weather & good breeze M.S.M.
Miel part under short sail Lat part
made sail steering S & E. so acc'd

Lat 31-54 N

Saturday Aug 23^d Long 49-44 WCom. with good breeze & squally from M.S.M.
at 3 P.M. saw white water 3 points of
sea here & ran for it but saw no more
Miel & Lat part same at 10 A.M.
passed a large whales Carcas emp. repair
Mainsail

Lat 32-13 N

Sunday Aug 24th Long 48-59 WCom. with light air & calms at 2 P.M.
saw something which looked like a
boat sail 4 mile off sent 3^d mate
to see what it was. proved to be a large
iron can. buoy No 3. Caught a barrel of
fish around it Miel & Lat part
calms & Light air

Lat 32-08 N

Long 48-34 W

Monday Aug 25thCom. with calms & light air at 1/2 past
2 P.M. took the buoy along side & took the
chain & a light which kept the buoy
