

Remarks on board Bark Perry 1849

Wednesday Sept 4th

Com. with good weather & fine breeze S.W.
Boat chasing at 4 P.M. The Carrie
Clark lowered her boat & rushed in with
ours & which prevented our boat from
striking a large whale at dusk gave up
the chase. Spike the capt of the Clark
in his boat was two months from home
& had taken 40 blbs Mid part under short
sail. Whales when last seen was going S.W.
Lat part at daylight made all sail the Bark
in sight off sea low. at 6 A.M. tacked ship
heading N.W.W. at 8 past 9 A.M. tacked
ship again S.W. & Bark in sight

Thursday Sept 5th

Com. with cloudy weather & fine breeze S.W.
Ship by the wind on port tack at 2 past 12
M. the Bertha hauled aback her mainyard
to gam. had taken 24 blbs this season the
Schr. also in sight at 11 P.M. finished
gaming ship under short sail head-
ing W. Lat part at daylight made all
steering N.W. Lat 34-05 N
Long 37-46 W

Friday Sept 6th

Com. with cloudy weather & good breeze
S.W. steering N.W. Bertha in sight at
sunset shortened sail & luffed to
the wind heading W. Mid part
Moderate Lat part light
breeze steering S.S.E. one sail & a
Steamer in sight steering E.
at 12 M. kept off W.

Lat 34-38 N
Long 38-40 W.

Saturday Sept 7th

Com. with light breeze S.W. at 7 P.M.
Shortened sail for the night (Mid part
fresh breeze lat part squally with heavy
rain at 6 A.M. made sail.

Sunday Sept 8th

Com. with fresh breeze S.W. & squally. Pumps
attended to at 7 P.M. shortened sail
for the night at daylight made sail
a heavy sea on Monday Sept 9th

Com. with good breeze & squally
steering E.N.E. Mid part steering W.E. Lat
part all sail out squally with all sail out
& a heavy swell

Lat 37-54 N
Long 35-46

Tuesday Sept 10th

Begins with strong breeze N.W. & a heavy
sea on. Pumped ship at 4 P.M. (400) seven
hundred strokes. Mid part do lat part
squally

Lat 38-49 N
Long 32-50 W

Wednesday Sept 11th

Com. with strong breeze N.W. steering E.N.E.
Pumps attended to Mid part the same
lat part at 8 A.M. saw corvo bearing S.W.
& kept off S.E. for flume a brig in sight
steering E. also another sail steering the same think
it is a whaler No Obs.

Thursday Sept 12th

Com. with strong breeze & frequent fog squally N.
steering for flume at 11 P.M. Capt went
on shore to the town of St. Cruz the Brig
Pernina H. Hill also lying off & on mid
part do Lat part the same at 9 A.M.
Lat Boat on shore & so end
