Saturday Sept 28th

Com. Cloudy Weather all hands on liberty

Sunday Sept 29th

Com. All hands on liberty light breeze S.E. & Overcast Lat past plenty rain

Monday Sept 30th

Com. rainy weather & wind S.E. all hands busy at work on oil

Tuesday Oct 1st

Com. With light E. Wind & cloudy emp. putting oil on shore & finished (355) three hundred & fifty five

Wednesday Oct 2^d

Com. fine weather & light air emp setting up shooks the Sage Phillips & the Francis Barstow sailed to day

Thursday Oct 3^d

Com. With blowing a gail S.W. emp setting up shooks for ground tier having some Blacksmith work done.

Friday Oct 4th

Com. With Cloudy weather & calm. employed setting up shooks & fitting copper & Black Smithing also got one raft of water 50 bbls

Sat Oct 5th

Com. fine weather emp taking aboard water must part fine Lat past one watch on liberty so on do

Sunday Oct 6th

Com. squally rainy weather watch on liberty Lat past emp. getting water

Monday Oct 7th

Squally weather emp. getting water & stowing the ground tier & setting up shooks.

Com. With squally weather employed setting up shooks & getting water.

Wednesday Oct 9th

Com. With good weather & good breeze N.E. Wm. B. Pease a Boatster returned to the ship

Thursday Oct 10th

Com. With cloudy weather & light breeze employed getting water. Mr. Kelliker came for his discharge.

Friday Oct 11th

Com. With fine weather employed getting ready for sea.

Saturday Oct 12th

Com. With fine weather. Wind. part done lat part one watch ashore on liberty.

Sunday Oct 13th

Com. With fine weather one watch ashore on liberty. Lat. past employed getting water.

Monday Oct 14th

Com. With fine weather employed getting water & getting ship ready for sea.

Tuesday Oct 15th

Com. With good weather & strong Breeze E.S.E. employed getting ship ready for sea.

Wednesday Oct 16th

Com. With good weather employed getting ship ready for sea lat past receiving Provisioning.
