

Remarks onboard Bark Perry of Astoria
1879

offednesday Oct 29th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from the S.W. and rugged steering S by S Middle part the same latter part wind NW ship making no water to speak of so ends

Thursday Oct 30th

All these 24 hours strong breeze W to NW steering S by E latter part at 7 AM saw the Island of Palmar and the Canaries bearing W S W 50 mile Dist also two sails

Friday Oct 31st

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from the S.W. heading by the wind to the S.E. at 1 PM saw the E end of Penriffs bearing S.E. by S 30 mile Dist Middle part light winds and calm from various points latter part strong gale and thick cloudy weather heading to the S.E. under short sail

Saturday Nov 1st

First part of these 24 hours strong gale from the S.W. heading by the wind to the S.E. under short weather thick and cloudy at 1 PM saw the East end of Grand Canaries bearing S 20 mile Dist Middle & latter part light baffling winds under the lee of the land

Sunday Nov 2nd

First part of these 24 hours light baffling winds ~~at~~ 10 mile Dist at 2 PM took a fresh breeze from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.E. Middle & latter part light breezes heading to the S.E.

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Monday Nov 3rd

First part of these 24 hours light breeze from the S.W. heading by the wind to the S.E. saw Cape Rafalere Dist 20 mile Middle & latter part light air and calm the Land 8 mile Dist sent a boat a fishing

Tuesday Nov 4th

First part of these 24 hours Moderate breeze from the W or W. steering S by W the Land in sight from 5 to 10 mile Dist Middle part the same latter part dark cloudy weather steering S by W

Wednesday Nov 5th

First part of these 24 hours light breeze with thick cloudy weather steering S by W the Land still in sight Middle & latter part calm

Thursday Nov 6th

First part of these 24 hours light air and calm the Land still in sight at 1 PM have two off Cintra Bay and sent two boats in a fishing at 6 PM boats returned with a few fish Middle part the same latter part calm sent two boats into the bay and found it very rugged inside at 10 PM returned on board

Friday Nov 7th

All these 24 hours calm the Land still in sight saw two Spanish fishing vessels
