

Remarks on board Friday Nov 21st 1862
 This day fine weather wind unsteady
 ship under all sail middle part rainey
 with a light breeze from E.S.E. latter part
 about the same

Remarks on board Saturday Nov 22nd
 This day commenced with fine weather
 and a light breeze from E.S.E. employed
 fitting foretopgallant mast middle part light
 breeze from the East. and rain squalls
 ship steering S.W. under all sail
 latter part fine weather with light breezes
 ship by the wind employed fitting
 foretopgallant mast and repairing sails
 so ends this twenty four hours

Remarks on board Sunday Nov 23rd
 This twenty four hours commenced with calm
 weather 5 ships in sight bent flying jib
 and on bent main topmast stay sail middle squally
 latter part fine with a moderate breeze
 from the south ship by the wind heading N.W.
 at 7 A.M. saw a shoal of Blackfish
 toward 3 boats waste boat struck one and
 killed him and sharks carried him off.

Remarks on board Monday Nov 24th 1862

This day commenced with squally weather and
 variable winds ship steering S. under all sail
 6 sail in sight middle part very rainy
 wind unsteady latter part fine weather with a
 moderate breeze from the south ship by the wind
 heading N.W. saw 10 sails from the mast
 heads employed repairing sails

 Long. by Chron. 26° 18' W.

Remarks on board Tuesday Nov 25th
 This twenty four hours commenced with good weather
 light breeze from the south ship by the wind
 heading N.W. with all sail set 4 ships in
 sight all heading N.W. repairing sails
 middle part squally with light winds
 latter part fine with a moderate breeze
 from the S.E. ship under all sail by the
 wind saw one sail to the leeward heading
 to the westward employed repairing sails

 Long. by Chron. 28° 02' W.

Remarks on board Wednesday Nov 26th
 This day commenced with fine weather and a
 moderate breeze ship by the wind heading
 S.W. middle part the same latter part fine with
 a moderate breeze from the S.E. ship by the wind
 sent up foretopgallant mast and yard
