The first part of this twenty four hours commenced fine wind East ship running South with all sail set painted waste boat middle part about the same latter part weather fine with light winds from the East ship running South with all set. saw a sail to the windward heading to the North employed fitting rigging

Remarks on board Wednesday Dec 10th

This day commenced with fine weather and small breezes from East ship running S. by N. 1/2 N. under all sail middle part the wind and weather the same latter part moderate breezes from E. S. E. ship running S. by N. 1/2 N. under all sail one sail in sight to the windward steering S. by N. set up fore topmast back stays and painted boats so ends this day

Remarks on board Thursday Dec 11th 1862

This day commenced fine at 2 P.M. it came on rain wind unsteady ship steering S. by S. 1/2 E. one sail in sight middle part squally weather latter part fine wind E. S. E. ship running S. by S. 1/2 E. under all sail one sail in sight to the windward steering S. by S. repairing sails

Remarks on board Friday Dec 12th 1862

This day commenced with fine weather ship running S. by N. wind E. S. E. one sail in sight to the North repaired fore sail middle part fine latter part good weather with a moderate breeze from the N. E. ship running S. by S. 1/2 E. under all sail saw a longish bark off Larberd beach employed repairing fore sail

Remarks on board Saturday Dec. 13th

The first part of this twenty four hours commenced with fine weather and moderate winds from N. E. ship steering S. by S. 1/2 E. saw a schooner to the southward by the wind heading to the N. E. set up fore topgallant rigging middle part small breezes latter part fine moderate breeze from the North ship running S. by S. 1/2 E. with all sail set one sail in sight

Remarks on board Sunday Dec. 14th

This day commenced with fine weather wind light from the North ship steering S. by S. 1/2 E. two ships in sight to the westward middle part squally weather and winds unsteady latter part cloudy wind N. E. ship running S. by S. 1/2 E. one brig past heading N. E.
