Remarks on board Monday Dec. 15th 1862

This day commenced with squally weather wind unsteady ship by the wind heading to the eastward at 6 P.M. Tacked ship and headed S.W. at 7 P.M. hauled all light sails middle part cloudy with a strong breeze ship under a close reefed fore top sail and single reefed maine latter part still flowing strong from the S.W. at daylight set the courses

Remarks on board Tuesday Dec. 16th

This twenty four hours commenced with clear weather and a strong breeze from the S.W. by S. ship heading S.W. by S. at 3 o'clock more moderate turned the reef out of the maine top sail and set the fifth middle part still blowing strong from the S.W. by S. latter cloudy more moderate at daylight made all sail wind S.W. ship steering S.W.

Remarks on board Wednesday Dec. 17th 1862

This day twenty four hours commenced cloudy with a moderate breeze from the S.W. fore top gallant sail and flying jib hauled middle part squally all light sails hauled latter part fine weather with a moderate breeze from the S.W. at daylight made all sail at 10 A.M. wind hauled to set top mast and lower studding sails

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Remarks on board Thursday Dec 18th 1862

The first part of this twenty four hours commenced with fine weather with a strong breeze from the S.W. ship running S.W. by W. at 1 o'clock took in the studding sail employed fitting rigging middle part about the same latter part fine wind S.W. ship running S.W. by W. spoke Barker Union of New Bedford Capt. Foster. Bailing they saw whales too days running got a letter and papers heard from Roswell King with the schooner Tucker

This day commenced with fine weather wind S.W. ship running S.W. by W. middle part strong breeze latter part strong breeze from the S.W. ship running S.W. by W.

Remarks on board Saturday Dec 20th

This day commenced with cloudy weather and a strong breeze from the S.W. ship running S.W. at 6 A.M. luffed to the ship under close reef maine top sail & reefed fore sail fore top mast and mizzen stay sails middle part raining latter part winds unsteady fine weather ship by the wind employed setting up rigging
