This day commenced fine weather with a light breeze from the S. ship steering S. by E. under all sail at sun down came on squally look in fore and main topgallant sails and fly jib and gaff top sail middle part squally latter part fine make all sail steering East. by E.

Remarks on board Sunday April 19<sup>th</sup>

This twenty four hours commenced with fine weather ship under all sail steering S. by E. wind unsteady middle part fine weather ship under all sail steering S. by E. latter part the same

Remarks on board Monday April 20<sup>th</sup>

This day commenced with fine weather and light winds from the North by East ship under all sail heading S. by E. saw a steamer steering South middle part fine with light winds from the North & Westward ship under all sail steering S. by E. latter part wind & weather the same sent a clew gaff top sail
