Remarks on board Tuesday April 21st 1863

This twenty four hours commenced with fine weather and moderate breezes from the N.E. ship under all sail heading E by S. saw school of pumps middle part fine with light winds from the North latter part the same ship under all sail at day light saw a brig steering to the S.E.

Remarks on board Wednesday April 22nd

This day commenced with light winds and variable ship with all sail set steering E by S. middle part about the same latter part fine weather winds variable so ends this twenty four hours

Remarks on board Thursday April 23rd

This twenty four hours commenced with fine weather and light winds from the North and westward at 4 P.M. wind haled to the E by S. ship under all sail middle and latter part calm and squally weather at 8 A.M. saw bark corselia the mate went on board the Capt came here joined all day

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Remarks on board Friday April 24th 1863

This day commenced with variable winds and weather ship under all sail by the wind gaining with the bark corselia middle part a moderate breeze from the E.S. ship by the wind under all sail heading to the south east latter part fine weather and a moderate wind ship heading E by S. corselia still in sight

Remarks on board Saturday April 25th

This day commenced with good weather and strong wind from E.S. ship under all sail at 4 P.M. took in fore top gallant sail and gaff top sail middle and latter part moderate winds and fine weather ship by the wind heading E by S. bark corselia in sight to the westward

Remarks on board Sunday April 26th

This day commenced with fine weather and strong breeze from the E.S. ship by the wind heading E.S. under all sail middle part strong breeze from E.S. ship by the wind heading E by S. latter part about the same two sail in sight to the westward by the wind heading E by S.
