

Bound Towards Samarang

Remarks on board Tuesday June 30th 1863

This day commenced with strong winds from the E.S.E. ship by the wind latter part the same at 8 A.M. kept the ship off for the Harbor of Samarang at 10 A.M. Capt and boats crew went on shore ship laying off and on

Remarks on board Wednesday July 1st

This day commenced with strong breezes ship lying off and on at St. Helena Capt on shore at 8 P.M. Capt came on board and stood off shore middle and latter part strong winds ship heading East under double reefed Topsails

Remarks on board Thursday July 2nd

This twenty four hours commenced with good weather and strong breezes ship by the wind under single reefed Topsails middle part double reefed Topsails split the file latter part strong winds ship running E.S.E.

Remarks on board Friday July 3rd

This day commenced strong Trades ship steering E.S.E. under single reefed Topsails middle and latter part the same

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Remarks on board Saturday July 4th 1863

This day commenced with fine weather and moderate breezes from S.E. ship steering E.S.E. with all sail middle and latter part about the same

Remarks on board Sunday July 5th

This twenty four hours commenced with moderate breezes from S.E. ship running E.S.E. with all sail set middle and latter part the same

Remarks on board Monday July 6th

This twenty four hours commenced with fine weather and moderate breezes ship steering E.S.E. with all sail set middle and latter part the same

Remarks on board Tuesday July 7th

This twenty four hours commenced with fine weather and light winds from S.E. ship running E.S.E. middle and latter part the same

Remarks on board Wednesday July 8th

This twenty four hours commenced with fine weather and light winds from the S.E. ship running to the E.S.E. middle and latter part the same
