

Bound Towards the Coast of Africa

Remarks on board Sunday July 19th 1863

This day commenced with fine weather and light airs from the South ship by the wind heading E.S.E. at 4 P.M. Tacked ship heading N.E. by E. Middle part moderate winds from E.S.E. ship by the wind latter part winds light

Remarks on board Monday July 20th

This twenty four hours commenced with fine weather and light winds from South ship by the wind on the Starboard Tack with all sail set at 4 P.M. Tacked ship. Middle part weather the same latter part fine at 11 A.M. saw a school of seals toward all three boats larboard boat struck and got one

Remarks on board Tuesday July 21th

This day commenced with fine weather and light winds employed cutting up the flubber. Middle and latter part fine weather and light winds at 11 A.M. made the land

Remarks on board Wednesday July 22th

This twenty four hours commenced with fine weather and light winds from South ship all sail set at dark let go larboard anchor of the coast of Africa in 11 fathoms of water. Middle part still lying at anchor latter part lying at anchor boats all off after bump backs

Lying At Anchor off Coast of Africa

Remarks on board Thursday July 23rd 1863

This day commenced with fine weather and light winds ship still lying at anchor with the boats off after bump backs. Middle part fine latter part fine at 8 A.M. toward the boats for whales but with success

Remarks on board Friday July 24th

This day still lying at anchor boats off came on board 5 o'clock without success. Middle part fine ship lying at anchor latter part fine with a moderate breeze from the S.E. at day light got the ship under way and stood out and to sea with all sail set

Remarks on board Saturday July 25th

This twenty four hours commenced with fine weather and moderate breeze from the S.E. ship by the wind heading S.W. with all sail set middle and latter part the same

Remarks on board Sunday July 26th

This day commenced with fine weather and light winds ship with all sail set steering S.E. middle part the same latter part fine with unsteady winds and calms

Remarks on board Monday July 27th
This day fine at 10 o'clock made the land bearing E.
