This day commenced with fine weather and moderate breezes from the S.W. ship with all sail heading to Eastward nothing in sight at sun down singled reefed the top sails and banded the main sail middle part strong breezes latter part the same

Remarks on board Tuesday Nov 10th

This twenty four hours commenced with strong breezes and cloudy weather at 10 o'clock kept the ship off S.W. and run untill 4 P.M. and then luffed to the wind ship under reefed top sails main spencer and foretopmast stay sail middle and latter part the same

Remarks on board Wednesday Nov 11th

This day commenced with strong breezes from the south and Westward ship under small sail at 2 P.M. spoke Bark Cornelia of New Bedford capt went on board at 6 o'clock came on board again middle and latter part strong breeze ship with small sail

Bound Towards St. Helena

Remarks on board Thursday Nov 12th 1863

This day commenced with strong breezes from the S.W. ship running off S.W. under small sail at sun down luffed to the wind middle and part fine latter part moderate breezes from S.W. at 7 P.M. kept the ship off to the S.W. and made all sail

Remarks on board Friday Nov 13th

This day commenced with fine weather and moderate breezes from the South & Westward ship under all sail steering S.W. by W. middle and latter part about the same

This twenty four hours commenced with fine weather and moderate breezes from S.W. ship running S.W. with all sail set middle and latter part the same employed reaving dew braces
