 This day commenced with fine weather and strong breezes from the S.W. ship under double reefed topsails and courses at 5 P.M. more moderate
 turned the reefs out and ^{set} the full & by full ship running East middle latter parts fine weather with a moderate wind from the S.W. ship steering E. by S.

Remarks on board Monday July 25th

This twenty four hours commenced fine weather and moderate breezes from the S.W. ship with all sail set steering E. by S. at 4 P.M. saw a school of grampasses middle part the same latter part fine with moderate winds from S.W. by E. ship steering E. by S. with all sail set

Bound to the South and Eastward

Remarks on board Tuesday July 26th 1864

This twenty four hours commenced with good weather and moderate breezes from the S.W. ship with all sail set running South East saw a bark to the windward steering to the N. all hands employed sail repairing middle and latter part wind and weather the same saw a ship to the south steering East

Remarks on board Wednesday July 27th

This day commenced with fine weather and light winds from the S.W. ship steering to the E. by S. by Compass employed repairing main top sail saw a white water ahead middle part the same latter part fine with light winds from the N.E. ship running to the E. by S. with all sail set saw a sail to the south steering E. so ends this day

Remarks on board Thursday July 28th

This day commenced with fine weather and light winds from the S.W. ship with all sail set steering to the E. by S. one bark in sight bound to the E. employed repairing main top sail middle part about the same latter part winds & weather the same at 4 P.M. spoke bright school boat on the starboard tack and huffed to the wind on the starboard tack
