Remarks on board Friday July 29th 1864

This day commenced with fine weather and moderate breezes from the W.S.W. ship by the wind with top gallant sails hoisted at sun down double reefed the top sails for the night latter part fine at day light made all sail ship by the wind heading south at saw a sail to the seaward

Lat by obs 33.38 N.
Long by Chro 41.46 W.

Remarks on board Saturday July 30th

This day commenced with fine weather and moderate breezes from the W.S.W. ship by the wind with all sail out at sun down double reefed the top sails middle part fine latter part good weather and moderate winds at day light made all sail and kept the ship up by 11 o'clock saw two large sperm whales going to the windward quick did not lower

Lat by obs 33.45 N.
Long by Chro 41.51 W.

Remarks on board Sunday July 31st

This day commenced with light winds and fine weather ship by the wind at 6 P.M. Clewed down the top sails and lowered the boats and to practice the crews middle part calm latter part calm at day light made all sail at 6 A.M. saw sperm whales to the south west going quick did not lower

Lat by obs 33.45 N. Long by Chro 41.45 W.

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Remarks on board Monday Aug the 1st 1864

This day commenced with fine weather and calm at sundown hoisted fore and main top gallant sails middle and latter part the same

Lat by obs 33.40 N.
Long by Chro 41.51 W.

Remarks on board Tuesday Aug the 2nd

This day commenced with fine weather and moderate breezes from the eastward ship steering N with all sail set at sundown hoisted top gallant sails fly jib middle part the same latter part calm ship with all sail set saw a sail to the westward

Lat by obs 34.15 N.
Long by Chro 42.00 W.

Remarks on board Wednesday Aug the 3rd

This twenty four hours commenced with fine weather and light airs from the north-east ship by the wind heading S.E. middle and latter parts the same several sail in sight

Lat by obs 33.45 N.
Long by Chro 41.50 W.

Remarks on board Thursday Aug the 4th

This day commenced with a moderate breeze from the N.E. ship by the wind with all sail several ships in sight middle and latter part about the same

Lat by obs 34.00 N. Long by Chro 41.50 W.
