Remarks on board Thursday Aug 18th 1864

This twenty four hours commenced with calm weather ship with all sail set at sundown shortened sail for the night latter part moderate breezes from the N.W. at day light made all sail set too sail by the wind on the Port tack employed bracking out and showing over

Remarks on board Friday Aug 19th

This day commenced with fine weather and light winds from N.W. ship by the wind heading S.W. with all sail set nothing in sight at sundown shortened sail for the night middle part fine latter part moderate with squalls ship by the wind with light sails hauled in sail in sight to the westward

Remarks on board Saturday Aug 20th

This day commenced with squally weather at 1 o'clock double reefed the top sails and furled the main sail at 4 P.M. spoke bark Roscoe of New Bedford at 5 P.M. took in fore top sail middle part the same latter part began with moderate breezes from the N.W. ship by the wind at day light made all sail at 11 A.M. wind hauled to the Eastward kept ship off N.W. Roscoe in sight to the windward

Cruising on the Western Ground

Remarks on board Sunday Aug 21st 1864

This day commenced with fine weather and light winds from Eastward ship running N.W. at 4 P.M. ship by the wind with all sail set after supper Capt went on board bark Roscoe came on board again at 10 o'clock middle part fine ship with short sail latter part commenced with moderate breezes at 8 A.M. wind came out to the N.W. and blowed a gale fore the ship too under boat reefed main top sail fore top mast stay sail and main spencer Roscoe still in sight to the leeward

Remarks on board Monday Aug 22nd

This day commenced with strong gale from the N.W. ship still lying too latter part more moderate set the fore sail fore top sail and one reef out of the main top sail one sail to the leeward

Remarks on board Tuesday Aug 23rd

This day commenced with strong breezes and a heavy sea ship under double reefed top sails about 1 o'clock took in the fore top sail and fore sail and double reefed the main top sail at 5 more moderate set fore sail again middle part the same latter part still blowing strong too sail to the leeward
