Remarks on board Monday Sept 5th 1864
 This day commenced with moderate breeze from the West ship by the wind heading N.W. with all sail set saw several sail at sundown shortened sail as usual latter part strong breezes at day light made all sail ship by the wind heading S.W. at 9 o'clock double reefed the topsails fore stay parted sent it in an deck and repaired it

Remarks on board Tuesday Sept 6th
 This day commenced with strong winds from the W. by S ship heading S.W. by S under double reefed topsails set up fore stay middle and latter parts strong breeze spoke Bark Marcella

 This twenty four hours strong breezes from N.W. ship under short sail one sail in sight

Remarks on board Thursday Sept 8th
 This twenty four commenced with strong breezes from the N.W. ship lying too under reefed main topsail and fore sail topmast stay sail and main speaker employed repairing fore main topsail middle part the same latter part strong breeze ship under small sail

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Remarks on board Friday Sept 9th 1864
 This day moderate ship under all sail wind to the North at 5 P.M. spoke Bark Marcella in went on board came back at 9 P.M. middle part ship under short sail latter part squally weather with rain ship under double reefed topsails steering S.W.

Remarks on board Saturday Sept 10th
 This day commenced with squally weather ship running to the N and westward made all sail at sundown trim fore topmast and double reefed the main for the night latter part quite moderate ship by the wind at day light set fore topsail fore and main sail at 9 a.m. kept ship off North saw two whale ships steering to the North

Remarks on board Sunday Sept 11th
 This day commenced with squally weather ship running to the North at 4 o'clock took in the fore topsail and double reefed the main and fuffed to the wind on the Starboard tack at dark shortened sail as usual latter part light airs from the N.W. day light made all sail ship by the wind
